

ORDINANCE NO. 486.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROHIBITION OF SKATEBOARDING WITHIN THE BUSINESS DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

It is unlawful for any person to ride skateboards on any sidewalk, street or alley at any time within the City of Polson Business District and more specifically described as follows:


First Street West from Second Avenue to Fifth Avenue;
Main Street from Kootenai Avenue to Fifth Avenue East;
Kootenai Avenue from Second Avenue to First Street East;
First Avenue West from Kootenai Avenue to First Street East;
Second Avenue from First Street West to 5th Street East;
Second, Third, and Fourth Avenues from First Street West to Second Street East;

A skateboard is a device consisting of a board made of any material onto which wheels are attached and upon which a person propels themselves.


Any person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars or more than fifty dollars; provided however that anyone under the age of 18 accused of violating this ordinance shall be charged in youth court and punished in the discretion of that court.

REPEALING CLAUSE: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
