

ORDINANCE NO. 511

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER III, SECTION 3.01, OF ORDINANCE NO. 501 - TO PROVIDE FOR CHANGES IN THE MEMBERSHIP AND TERMS OF THE BOARD MEMBERS AND TO PROVIDE LIMITATIONS REGARDING THE OFFICERS OF THE BOARD.

Section 3.01 shall be amended to read as follows:

There shall be created a commission to be known and designated as "Tree Commission" composed of seven (7) members, all of whom shall be year round residents of the Polson area. All seven (7) of said members shall be appointed by the Mayor with approval of the City Council.

All members of the Commission shall serve without pay.

The seven members appointed by the Mayor shall be appointed as follows:

Four (4) for five (5) year terms and three (3) for three (3) year terms and serve until their successors are duly appointed and approved by the Council.

Subsequent to the initial appointment, all new appointees shall be appointed for five (5) year terms; provided, however, that in the event of vacancy caused by resignation, death, or otherwise, the member's successor shall be appointed to fill out the unexpired term of the member replaced.

The Tree Commission shall appoint, on an annual basis, a Chairman and a Secretary of the Commission, whose terms shall be for one year. No person shall be an officer for more than one successive one year term.

In addition, there is hereby created an Advisory Board to the Tree Commission, the membership of which shall consist of the Superintendent of the Polson Water and Sewer Department and the Superintendent of the Polson Parks and Streets Department, and two additional individuals with appropriate backgrounds in landscaping or experience with plants, trees and shrubs, whose terms shall be for two years each.
