

ORDINANCE NO. 516

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT LAKE COUNTY'S FLOOD PLAIN REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF POLSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Polson is mandated by State law under M.C.A. Section 76-5-101, et seq. (1991), to adopt Flood Plain Regulations in order to prevent and alleviate flooding threats to life and health and to reduce private and public economic losses; and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill its responsibilities under the law, the Polson City Council has determined to adopt and incorporate by reference the existing approved regulations now in effect and as adopted by the Commissioners of Lake County and to utilize for administrative purposes in connection with the administration of said regulations, the officials designated by Lake County to administer its regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Polson does hereby adopt and incorporate by reference as though fully set forth herein, Resolution No. 816 adopted by the Lake County Commissioners and dated July, 1991, as the Flood Plain Regulations to be applied within the corporate limits of the City of Polson, subject to the following:

1. All references within Lake County Resolution No. 816 specific to Lake County shall, within the context of this Ordinance, be construed as the City of Polson;


2. All reference within Resolution No. 816 to the governing officials shall, within the context of this Ordinance, be construed as the governing officials of the City of Polson, with the exception however that the City of Polson designates the Lake County Flood Plain Administrator to serve in the same capacity as the City of Polson Flood Plain Administrator;

3. Under Paragraph 4.04 of the Flood Plain Regulations pertaining to the Flood Plain Management Board of Adjustments, the City of Polson does hereby designate its Zoning Board of Adjustment to serve in the same capacity as the Flood Plain Board of Adjustment. The procedures of the Board acting in this capacity shall be those set forth within Paragraph 4.04 rather than the procedures outlined for Zoning Board of Adjustment matters.


