

ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT STATE OF MONTANA TECHNICAL CODES FOR THE CITY OF POLSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has in effect various codes for building, electrical, plumbing, fire, mechanical, energy, administration, zoning, signs, abatement of dangerous buildings, and housing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson wishes to adopt the most recently adopted State of Montana technical codes pursuant to M.C.A. Section 7-5-4202, as follows, to-wit:

- Uniform Building Code, 1991 Edition, and the 1992 Supplement to the Uniform Building Code, U.B.C. Standards, Uniform Mechanical Code, Uniform Administrative Code, Uniform Fire Code, and the U.F.C. Standards
- Uniform Electrical Code, 1993 Edition
- Uniform Plumbing Code, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Fire Code, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Mechanical Code, 1991 Edition
- Model Energy Code, 1992 Edition
- Uniform Administrative Code, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Zoning Code, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Sign Code, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Code for Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1991 Edition
- Uniform Housing Code, 1991 Edition
- NFPA Life Safety Code, 1991 Edition;

and

WHEREAS, the City of Polson has caused to be published in the Lake County Leader, at least 15 days prior to final action by the City Council, a Notice of Intent to adopt the above-referenced technical code in whole by reference, and a copy of the Code to be adopted has been filed with the Clerk of the City of Polson for inspection by the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City of Polson does hereby adopt the above-referenced technical code in whole by reference.

In addition to the penalty enforcement provisions set forth within the Codes adopted here or otherwise provided in State law, any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County jail for a period in exceeding six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance supersedes and repeals Title 15 - Chapters 15.02, 15.04, 15.06, 15.08, 15.10, 15.14, 15.16, 15.18, 15.22, 15.22.030 and 15.22.040, and shall be codified as Section 15.01. Existing Section 15.06.040 shall remain in full force and effect and shall be recodified as Section 15.02. Section 15.12 and Section 15.20 shall remain in full force and effect without codification change.
