

ORDINANCE NO. 544AN ORDINANCE TO REPLACE SECTION 14.02.040 OF THE POLSON CITY CODE
RELATIVE TO RULES OF RIVERSIDE PARK:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Polson that Section 14.02.040 of the Polson City Code is replaced with the following language:

14.02.040 Riverside Park. (A) Riverside Park shall provide the public with accessible water frontage for swimming facilities, docking facilities, pier, playground, restroom facilities and picnic areas, which shall be available for use and enjoyment by the general public without charge. The park shall be open from May 1 through September 30 of each year.

(B) There shall be no overnight camping in the Park.

(C) Only concessions related to water-related activities will be allowed in Riverside Park. These concessions shall be limited to activities involving boating, rafting, diving, water skiing, jet skiing, water-related tour activities and swimming activities. No person, firm, or corporation shall be permitted to operate any concession within the Riverside Park area without first obtaining a permit from the City of Polson. Applicants shall submit written application together with fees established for such activities (Ord. 446).

(D) Public drinking and public display and exhibition of alcoholic beverages as defined in Chapter 9.14.010 shall be permitted in Riverside Park from May 1 through September 30 of each year.

(E) The City Park Board shall set the time each evening after which the general public will be excluded from the park.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


