

ORDINANCE NO. 566

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING SIDEWALK DISPLAYS IN THE CITY OF POLSON

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA

WHEREAS, the City of Polson, by and through its Council, duly adopted Ordinance No. 565 at its regular meeting on July 19, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance No. 565 is denominated an emergency ordinance and went into effect on July 19, 1999; and,

WHEREAS, the City now desires to adopt a more permanent scheme of regulation, administration, and permitting governing sidewalk displays by merchants and others within the City limits of the City of Polson, all as set forth in Exhibits A and C hereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Council intends to adopt herein the terms of the previous emergency Ordinance with the alterations and additions more particularly set forth below; and,

WHEREAS, this Ordinance shall supersede the terms now set forth at Section 12.02.250 and 12.02.260 of the Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:


- Section 1. The foregoing are not recitals but are a part of this ordinance.
- Section 2. Exhibit A hereto is adopted wholly in the place and stead of the existing Municipal Code Section 12.02.250 and 12.02.260, deleting the existing terms of Section 12.02.260 in their entirety.
- Section 3. Exhibit C is adopted as the form of permit to be used by official of the City of Polson in administering the terms of Section 12.02.250.
- Section 4. All other code Sections or parts of Sections in conflict herewith are, to the extent of conflict, repealed.
- Section 5. Ordinance No. 565 is repealed upon the effective date of the within and foregoing Ordinance.


REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EXHIBIT "A"

Section 12.02.250 REWORDED THIS SECTION WITH NEW CONDITIONS

Permits and conditions of sidewalk displays.

Sidewalk displays shall be allowed to be placed on or above the sidewalks in the area from First Avenue to Fifth Avenue and First Street West to Second Street East subject to the following requirements:

1. The applicant must receive City Council approval
2. The location shall have a sidewalk with a minimum width of ten (10) feet.
3. The permit shall be valid for one year (April 1st to March 31st), and must be renewed annually.
4. A sketch must be provided that depicts the size and location of the requested item(s) within the City right-of-way.
5. This revocable permit is non-transferable and good for the listed item(s), business and address on the permit application.
6. The City of Polson reserves the right not to renew permits.
7. The owner must secure and furnish a certificate of liability insurance, with coverage of \$1,000,000 per occurrence naming the City of Polson as additionally insured.
8. A minimum five (5) foot sidewalk aisle shall be maintained for pedestrian travel at all times.
9. The item(s) shall be placed so as not to impede pedestrian traffic and/or safety.
10. This permit is specific to the right-of-way in front of the business applying for the permit.
11. The owner shall obey all state and local statutes and ordinances that are applicable to the encroachment.
12. The permittee shall indemnify the city against any and all liability, loss or damage that the city may suffer as a result of claims, demands, costs or judgements resulting from the item(s) in the public right-of-way. (Exhibit "C")

It is expressly understood and agreed that the undersigned agrees to maintain and leave all facilities in a clean, safe, and sanitary manner, at no cost to the City of Polson, and shall comply with all ordinances, conditions, statutes and regulations applicable thereto. Failure to do so will result in the undersigned paying all costs incurred by the City of Polson to return the premises to it's original condition.

THE CITY OF POLSON RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE OR TERMINATE THIS PERMIT AT ANY TIME BY GIVING 30 DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE OF SUCH REVOCATION OR TERMINATION, EXCEPT THAT THE CITY MAY, AT ITS ELECTION, REVOKE OR TERMINATE THE PERMIT AT ANY TIME WITHOUT GIVING ANY NOTICE IF THE OWNER FAILS TO COMPLY WITH OR ABIDE BY EACH AND ALL OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PERMIT.

Further, the undersigned acknowledges that this special permit is active for the specified dates and times noted under the general conditions, and that the permit is nontransferable.
