

ORDINANCE NO. 568

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT CROSS-STREET PARKING:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

WHEREAS, the Polson Police Department has observed numerous instances where motor vehicle operators have turned left across the centerline of city streets in order to park their vehicles along the curb or side of the opposite lane of traffic; and,

WHEREAS, because this practice by motor vehicle operators requires the operator to cross into oncoming traffic in the opposite lane it presents a danger to public health and safety; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Polson desires to render this practice unlawful and punishable as specified in the Municipal Code for the City of Polson.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

- 1. That the following prohibition is to be inserted as Section 10.04.110 (L), Polson Municipal Code:

It shall be unlawful for vehicles to cross into the oncoming traffic lane and park on the opposite side of the road.

- 2. That the fine to be assessed for the proscribed conduct shall be that provided for misdemeanors elsewhere in the Polson Municipal Code.
- 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Effective Date: April 5, 2000

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


FIRST READING: February 22, 2000.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the subject Ordinance shall become effective on March 21, 2000.


