

ORDINANCE NO. 577

**AN ORDINANCE TO ABANDON CERTAIN STREETS AND ALLEYS IN POLSON CITY CENTER ADDITION**

WHEREAS, the City of Polson plans to make improvements to that certain real property owned by the City of Polson and known commonly as O'Malley Park, and has determined that the streets and alleys therein are platted but have not been developed for use; and,

WHEREAS, the City caused to be issued a Resolution of Intent to Abandon, Resolution # 814, identifying those certain streets and alleys which the City intended to abandon; and,

WHEREAS, notice was properly given pursuant to Section 7-3-4448(2), Montana Code Annotated, and public hearing was held thereon on April 16, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, less than 51% of the affected property owners objected to the proposed abandonment; and,

WHEREAS, all predicates necessary to the within abandonment have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON

1. That the following streets and alleys are hereby abandoned:

10<sup>th</sup> Avenue East between 2<sup>nd</sup> Street East and 4<sup>th</sup> Street East.

3<sup>rd</sup> Street East between 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue East and Lot 31, Block 3 and Lot 19, Block 2, Polson City Center Addition.

Platted alley from 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue East through block 6 to Lot 31 and lot 20 of block 3, Polson City Center Addition.

Platted alley in Block 2 from Lots 25-26 to lots 13-38, Polson City Center Addition.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause to be filed with the Clerk & Recorder, Lake County, Montana, the within Ordinance, or any other or further notice as that office deems necessary for the purpose of recording the abandonments.

3. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the subject Ordinance shall become effective on June 7, 2001.
