ORDINANCE NO. 583

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR PARKING RESTRICTIONS:

WHEREAS, the City of Polson maintains and operates street cleaning equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the presence of parked vehicles during street cleaning operations adversely affects the ability of the Street Department to adequately clean several City streets; and,

WHEREAS, the City wishes to improve the appearance of the Main Street area by having regular and effective street cleaning and requiring that no person may park or otherwise leave a vehicle curbside on Main Street during the periods designated for street cleaning thereof by appropriate amendment herein of existing parking ordinances, and,

WHEREAS, the City desires that the terms of this Ordinance go into immediate effect prior to the advent of the usual summer high-traffic season and therefore shall pass this Ordinance as an emergency ordinance as contemplated in Sections 7-5-4203 and 4204, M.C.A.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are not mere recitals but part and parcel of this Ordinance.
- 2. This Ordinance shall be an emergency ordinance as the terms hereof are immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
- 3. Chapter 10.04.110 of the Municipal Code (Stopping, Standing, or parking prohibited in specified places) shall be amended to include therein subsection (L), to wit: "It shall be unlawful for any person to park or stand any vehicle on Main Street anywhere along its length between U.S. Highway 93 and 5th Avenue on any Friday between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m."
- 4. In the event of such restricted parking the Street Department is authorized to contact a towing company for the purpose of removal of such vehicle, the expense thereof to be borne by the owner of the vehicle.
- 5. Effective date: In conformance with the law applicable to emergency ordinances this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.

REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereBy repealed.

FIRST READING: May 20, 2002 SECOND READING: June 3, 2002

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the subject Ordinance shall become effective on June 3, 2002.
