ORDINANCE NO. 585

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 10.04.110 OF THE
POLSON MUNICIPAL CODE:**

WHEREAS, the existing Chapter 10.04.110 of the Polson Municipal Code provides in several terms thereof for the prohibition of parking, stopping, or standing vehicles at certain places within the corporate limits of the City of Polson, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Polson has determined that in the interest of the public safety and emergency measure is required to amend the said Chapter 10.04.110 of the Polson Municipal Code in order to prohibit the parking of vehicles on the access road running generally north and south along the eastern border of Sacagawea Park, between its intersection with Kootenai Avenue on the south and the lift station on the north, and,

WHEREAS, the within measure was passed and approved by motion and unanimous consent at the regular meeting of the City Council on July 15, 2002.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:**

1. That Chapter 10.04.110 of the Polson Municipal Code is amended to include the following:

“(M) It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on the access road running generally north and south along the eastern border of Sacagawea Park, between its intersection with Kootenai Avenue on the south and the lift station on the north. The Street Department shall ensure that the roadway thereat is properly marked and signed.”

REPEALING CLAUSE: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

FIRST READING: July 15, 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved that the subject Ordinance shall become effective on July 15, 2002.
