

ORDINANCE NO. 656

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 .06.110 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODES TO PROVIDE FOR AN AUTOMATIC ALTERNATIVE REGULAR MEETING OF THE POLSON CITY COUNCIL :

Whereas, Montana law provides that public meetings may not be held on any day that the Federal government has denominated a national holiday; and,

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Polson desires to establish an automatic alternative regular City Council meeting day in the event of a conflict in schedule with any Federally-recognized national holiday, so as to prevent future recurring council action to reschedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

1. Chapter 2 of the Polson Municipal Code is amended to include a new second subpart of the following form:
“2.06.110. Automatic Alternative Rescheduling. On occasions when the regularly scheduled Polson city council meeting would fall on a Federally-recognized holiday, the Clerk shall instead schedule and notice that meeting for 7:00 p.m. the next-following Wednesday.”

REPEALING CLAUSE: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

FIRST READING: July 19, 2010.

SECOND READING: August 2, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, the foregoing Ordinance shall become effective on September 1, 2010.
