

RESOLUTION NO. 4

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF, STATING THE CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE AND AN APPROXIMATE ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND FIXING THE TIME WHEN THE COUNCIL WILL HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ITS FINAL ADOPTION.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

- SECTION 1. That there is hereby created a special improvement district, the boundaries of which are hereinafter described.
- SECTION 2. That the number of said special improvement district is hereby designated as number one.
- SECTION 3. That the boundaries of said district are hereby described and defined as follows:
Commencing at a point where the westerly line of Kootenai Avenue intersects the west line of Fourth Street (extended), thence south along the west line of Fourth Street to the northmost point of Lot 1, Block 3, thence in a southwesterly direction across Lots 1 and 2, Block 3 to the center of the south line of Lot 2, Block 3, thence in the same direction to the center line of A Street, thence west along the center line of A Street to the east line of Kootenai Avenue, thence southwesterly along the east line of Kootenai Avenue to the center line of the alley between Third and Fourth Streets; thence south along the center line of said alley to the center of E Street; thence west along the center line of E Street to its intersection with the center line of the alley between Second and Third Streets, thence north along the center line of said alley to the north line of B Street, thence west along the north line of B Street to the southwest corner of Block 4, thence along the east line of Lake Street to the center line of A Street, thence east along the center line of A Street to the west line of Kootenai Avenue, thence northeast along the west line of Kootenai Avenue to the point of beginning.
said district to include the west one-half of Lots 1 and 2, of Block 3, all of Block 4, Lots 7, 8 and 9, Block 5, the west half of Blocks 10, 14, and 19 and the east half of Block 11, 13 and 20 of the Government Townsite of Polson, Montana.
- SECTION 4. That the character of the improvements to be made in the said district are hereby described as follows:
the construction of concrete sidewalks and curbs on the east side of Kootenai Avenue and the east and west sides of Third Street within the boundaries of said district. Also the east side of Block 4, and along the north side of A Street from Kootenai Avenue east to the center line of Lot 2, Block 3, the north and south sides of B, C and D Streets from Third Street to the alley between Third and Fourth Streets, along the west half of the south side of Block 19 and the east half of the south side of Block 20 and along the north and south sides of B Street from Third Street west to the alley line in Block 11. The construction of a concrete crosswalk on the east side of Kootenai Avenue at A Street, four concrete crosswalks at the intersection of B Street and Third, four concrete crosswalks at the intersection of C Street and Third Street, four concrete crosswalks at the intersection of D and Third Streets, and one concrete crosswalk on north side of E Street across Third Street.
Also the grading, surfacing and graveling of the roadway of Third Street and Kootenai Avenue, and all of B, C and D Streets between Third Street and the alley between Third and Fourth Streets and all of A Street within the boundaries of said district.
- SECTION 5. That an approximate estimate of the cost of said improvements above described is \$10000 and an estimate of the cost of engineering, inspection and other expenses in connection with the construction of said improvements is the sum of \$250.

SECTION 6. That to defray the cost of said improvements an assessment shall be levied against all of the assessable property within said district, and each lot or parcel of land within this district shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets and alleys and public places.


SECTION 7. That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvements shall be extended over a period of eight years, and paid in eight equal annual installments or payments the first of which shall be paid in the year of 1912, and all deferred payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.

SECTION 8. That there is hereby created a fund to be known as "Special Improvement District No 1 Fund" out of which fund the cost of said improvements shall be paid in warrants drawn against said funds.

SECTION 9. That on the fifth day of February, 1912 at eight o'clock P.M. at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana (the same being the regular meeting place of the City Council) the City Council of the City of Polson, will meet to hear objections to the official and final adoption of this resolution, at which time and place any owner or agent of property within said district shall have the right to appear in person or by attorney and show cause if any there be, why said improvements shall not be made.

SECTION 10. This Resolution shall be published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper published in said City of Polson, on the 26th day of January, 1912.

Provisionally adopted and approved this 22nd day of January, 1912, and finally passed and approved the 5th day of February, 1912.




