## RESOLUTION NO. 5

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF, STATING THE CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE AND AN APPROXIMATE ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE COUNCIL WILL HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ITS FINAL ADOPTION.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Pobson, Mont:

- SECTION I. That there is hereby created a special improvement district, the boundaries of which are hereinafter described.
- SECTION 2. That the number of said special improvement district is hereby designated as number two.
- SECTION 3. That the boundaries of said district are hereby designated and defined as follows:

  Commencing at a point where the westerly line of Kootemai Avenue intersects the west line of Fourth Street(extended) thence east to the center line of the alley in Block 2, thence south along the center line of said alley and in the same direction along the center lines of Blocks 6, 9 and 15 to the center line of D Street, thence west along the center line of D Street to the cast line of Fourth Street, thence south along the east line of Fouth Street to the center line of E Street, thence west along the center line of E Street to the center line of the alley between Third and Fourth Streets, thence north along the center line of said alley to the east line of Kootenai Avenue, thence north-east along the east line of Kootenai Avenue to the center line of A Street, thence east, along the center line of A Street to a point opposite the center of Lot 2 in Block 3, thence in a north easterly direction to the north most point in Lot'l Block 3, thence along the west line of Fourth Street north to point of beginning.
- SECTION 4. That the character of the improvements to be made in said district are hereby described as follows; the construction of concrete sidewalks and curbs on the east and west sides of Fourth Street within the boundaries of said district, not including Block IS, and also the north and south sides of A, B, C and D Streets west of Fourth Street and included within the boundaries of said district. the construction of two concrete crosswalks at the intersection of Fourth Street and Kootenai Avenue, four concrete crosswalks at the intersection of Fourth and B Streets, four coherete crosswalks at the intersection of Fourth and B Streets, four coherete crosswalks at the intersection of Fourth and D Streets. Also the grading, surfacing and graveling of the riadway of Fourth Street and all of A, B, C and D Streets between Fourth Street and the center line of the alley between Fourth Street and the alley between Third and Fourth Streets within the boundaries of said district.
- SECTION 5. That an approximate estimate of the cost of said improvement above described is \$II000.and an estimate of the cost of engineering, inspection and other expense in connection with the construction of said improvements is the sum of \$250.

- SECTION 6. That to defray the cost of sais improvements an assessment shall be levied against all assessable property within the said district, and each lot or parcel of land within the district shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets and alleys and public places.
- SECTION 7. That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvements shall be extended over a period of eight years, and paid in eight equal annual installments or payments the first of which shall be paid in the year of 1912, and all defered payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.
- SECTION 8. That there is hereby created a fund to be known as .
  "Special Improvement District No 2. Fund" out of which fund, the cost of said improvements shall be paid in warrants drawn against said fund.
- SECTIONN9. That on the 23rd day of February, 1912, at eight o'clock P.M. at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, (the same being the regular meeting place of the City Council) the Council of the City of Polson, will meet to hear objections to the official and final adoption of this Resolution, at which time and place any owner or agent of property within said district shall have the right to appear in person or by attorney and show cause, if any there be, why said improvements shall not be made.

SECTION IO. This Resolution shall be published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper published in the said City of Polson, on the 16th day of February, 1912.
