

RESOLUTION NO. 6

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF, STATING THE CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE AND AN APPROXIMATE ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND FIXING THE TIME WHEN THE COUNCIL WILL HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ITS FINAL ADOPTION.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Mont.:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created a special improvement district, the boundaries of which are hereinafter described.

SECTION 2. That the number of said special improvement district is hereby designated as number three.

SECTION 3. That the boundaries of said district are hereby described and defined as follows:
Commencing at a point where the west line of Third Street and the center line of the alley in Block 23 intersect and extending west along the center line of the alley in Block 23 and 22 and in the same direction along the center line of Blocks 1 and 2 in Riverside Addition to the City of Polson to the west line of Maple Avenue, thence north to the north line of Riverside Avenue, thence north-east along the north line of Riverside Avenue to the north line of E Street, thence east along the north line of E Street to the west line of First Street, thence north along the west line of First Street to a point opposite the center line of the alley in Block 21 of the Government Townsite of Polson, Montana, thence east along the center line of said alley and in the same direction along the center line of Block 20 to the center line of the alley in said Block, thence south along the center line of said alley to the center line of E Street, thence east along the center line of E Street to the west line of Third Street, thence south along the west line of Third Street to the point of beginning.
Said district to include the south one-half of Block 21, the north one-half of Blocks 22 and 23, the north one-half of Blocks 1 and 2 in Riverside Addition, and Lots 7, 8 and 9 of Block 20 of the Government Townsite of Polson, Montana.

SECTION 4. That the character of the improvements to be made in said district are hereby described as follows:
the construction of concrete sidewalks and curbs along the south side of E Street from Third Street to the east line of Maple Avenue in Riverside Addition, and a concrete sidewalk and curbs along the north side of E Street from the center line of the alley in Block 20 west to the center line of the alley in Block 2 of Riverside Addition, concrete sidewalks and curbs along the east and west sides of Second Street within the boundaries of this district, concrete sidewalks and curbs on east and west sides of First Street south of E Street and on east side of First Street north of E Street, concrete sidewalks and curbs on the east and west sides of Hawthorne Avenue from E Street south to the center line of Blocks 1 and 2, Riverside Addition



four concrete crosswalks at the intersection of Second and E Streets, concrete crosswalks across Hawthorne and Maple Avenues also the alleys in Blocks 1 and 2 on the south side of E Street in Riverside Addition and one concrete crosswalk across the south one-half of E Street at the intersection of Third and E streets. Also the grading and surfacing of all streets and planting of trees inside the curb line included in the above described district.

SECTION 5. That an approximate estimate of the cost of said improvements above described is \$5000. and an estimate of the cost of engineering, inspection and other expenses in connection with the construction of said improvements is the sum of \$250.

SECTION 6. That to defray the cost of said improvements an assessment shall be levied against all the assessable property within said district, and each lot or parcel of land within this district shall be assessed with that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets and alleys and public places.

SECTION 7. That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvements shall be extended over a period of eight years, and paid in eight equal annual installments or payments the first of which shall be paid in the year of 1912 and all deferred payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.

SECTION 8. That there is hereby created a fund to be known as "Special Improvement District No. 3 Fund" out of which fund the cost of said improvements shall be paid in warrants drawn against said fund.

SECTION 9. That on the 23rd day of February, 1912 at eight o'clock P.M. at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, (the same being the regular meeting place of the City Council) the City Council of the City of Polson, will meet to hear objections to the official and final adoption of this resolution, at which time and place any owner or agent of property within said district shall have the right to appear in person or by attorney and show cause if any there be, why said improvements shall not be made.

SECTION 10. This Resolution shall be published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper published in said City of Polson, on the 16th day of February, 1912.

Provisionally adopted and approved this 13th day of February, 1912 and finally passed and approved the 23rd day of February, 1912.

RESOLUTION NO 7.

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO 2., STATING THE CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE AND AN APPROXIMATE ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND FIXING THE TIME WHEN THE COUNCIL WILL HEAR OBJECTIONS TO ITS FINAL ADOPTION.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. That the character of the improvements to be made in said district are hereby described as follows; the construction of concrete sidewalks and curbs on the south side of Kootenai Avenue from Fourth Street east to the center line of the alley in Block No 2., concrete sidewalks and curbs on the north and south sides of A, B and C Streets and the north side of D Street from Fourth Street east to the east boundary line of Improvement District No 2., Also the grading and surfacing of A, B, C, and D Streets east of Fourth Street within the boundaries of said district.

SECTION 2. That an approximate estimate of the cost of said improvements above described is \$1500., and an estimate of the cost of engineering, inspection and other expenses in connection with the construction of said improvements is the sum of \$50.

SECTION 3. That to defray the cost of said improvements an assessment shall be levied against all of the assessable property within said district, and each lot or parcel of land within this district shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets and alleys and public places.

SECTION 4. That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvements shall extend over a period of eight years, and paid in eight equal annual installments or payments the first of which shall be paid in the year of 1912, and all deferred payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.
