RESOLUTION NO. 12.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND CREATING SPECIAL SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. I IN THE CITY OF POLSON, COUNTY OF FLATHEAD, STATE OF MONTANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SEWERS IN SAID DISTRICT AND DESCRIBING BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND THE PROPERTY TO BE ASSESSED.

WHEREAS, the within and foregoing resolution Number 10 was on the 7th day of June, A. D. 1915, duly and regularly passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, and filed in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Polson:

AND WHEREAS the said City Council causes notice of the passage and adoption of said resolution to be published in the Flathead Courier a weekly newspaper, published in the City of Polson;

AND WHEREAS, the City Clerk of the City of Polson did on the 14th day of June A. D. 1915, being the day of the first publication of said notice, mail to each and every person, firm, corporation, or known agent thereof, having property within the proposed district, directed to the last known address of such person, firm, corporation, or agent, a notice of the passage and adoption of said resolution.

AND WHEREAS, said notices so published and mailed as aforesaid describe the general character of the improvement proposed to be made in said district, the estimated cost thereof, and stated the time and place set for the hearing of protest against the making of said improvement and the creation of said proposed district; and which said notices, referred to said resolution for the boundaries of said proposed district and for further particulars with reference thereto;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council have met in the regular session at the time and place fixed and set by said resolution and aforesaid notices for the hearing of the protests against the making of said proposed improvement and the creation of said proposed district and have heard and fully considered all such protests;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

That no protests have been made or filed with the City Clerk of the City of Polson, against the making of such proposed improvements and against a creation of such proposed district within the time specified and provided in resolution Number 10:

That there be and there is hereby created a special improvement district to be known and designated as Special Sewer Improvement District No. 1 of the City of Polson, Montana;

That the character of the improvements to be made in said district is described as follows, to-wit:

To construct sewers along streets and alleys as herein described; Beginning at a point that is hereby and hereinafter designated as the Initial Point, which is the intersection of the center line of E and 1st Streets, of the original Townsite of the City of Polson, Montana; thence in a northerly direction along the center line of 1st Street, between Block 21 of the original Townsite of said City and the city limits of said City, 380 feet to the intersection of the center line of 1st and D Streets; thence North $0^{\circ} 17'$ East 660 feet to a point in the Flathead River, and again,

Beginning at the Initial Point, thence in a southerly direction along the center line of 1st Streets, between Block 22 of said original Townsite of the said city of Polson and Block 1 of Riverside addition to said City of Polson, 190 feet to a point on a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 22 and 23 of the original Townsite of the said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 480 feet, to a point on a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 22 and 23 of said Original Townsite of said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley to a point where the line running through the center of said alley intersects the center line of 2nd Street of said City; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 340 feet to a point where the center line of said alley intersects the east boundary line of said Block 23, and again

Beginning at the Initial Point, thence westerly along the center line of E Street of said City between Block 1 of said Riverside Addition to the City of Polson and the city limits of said City, 190 feet, to a point where a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 1 and 7 of Riverside Addition to said City of Polson, intersects the center line of E street of said city; thence southerly in said Riverside Addition to said City along the center line of said alley, 380 feet, to a point where a line running through the center of said alley intersects the center line of E Street of said City; thence southerly along the center line of said alley, 340 feet to a point where said center line of said alley intersects the south boundary line of Block 7 of said Riverside Addition to said City, and again

Beginning at a point 190 feet in a northerly direction from said initial Point along the center line of 1st Street in said City of Polson, which point is the intersection of said center line of said 1st street with a line running through the center of the alley which divides Block 21 of the said original townsite of said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 430 feet, to a point where the center line of said alley intersects the east boundary line of said block 21 of said original townsite of said City of Polson

Said lots, pieces or parcels of land being benefitted and assessed in the construction of said sewer are as follows, to-wit:

All of lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in Block No. 1 of Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Also all of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in Block 7 of Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16 in Block 21 of the City of Polson.

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 in Block 22 of the City of Polson.

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in Block 23 of the City of Polson.

And also lot No. 7 in Block 12 of the City of Polson.

That the boundaries of said Special Sewer Improvement District No. 1 shall be and the same are hereby declared to be the same as described in the within and foregoing Resolution No. 10 to which reference is hereby made for a particular description thereof.

That reference to the within and foregoing resolution No. 10 is hereby made for further particulars.

That it is hereby ordered and directed that said improvements be made in Special Improvement District in accordance with the plans and specifications thereof to be prepared by the City Engineer of the City of Polson.
