RESOLUTION NO 16

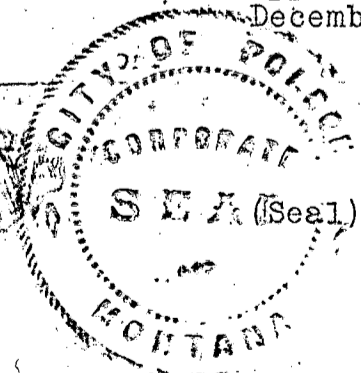
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA

Section 1. - That the Public Service Commission law should be amended so as to deprive the Public Service Commission of control of public utilities, owned and controlled by the Cities and Towns of the State of Montana

Section 2 - That the City Clerk be directed to furnish a copy of this resolution to State Senator Fred Whiteside and State Representatives James Harbert, P.N. Bernard, Percy F. Dodds and Emma A. Ingalls.
