

RESOLUTION NO 18

Whereas the City Council of the City of Polson, on the 9th day of April, 1917 duly and regularly passed and adopted a resolution declaring it to be to the best interest of the City of Polson and of the Church Addition, that the Boundaries of said City be extended so as to include within the Corporate limits the said Church Addition, and

Whereas, the City Council caused to be published in the Flathead Courier, a paper nearest to the said tract of land and addition once a week for two successive weeks a notice to the effect that said resolution had been duly and regularly passed, and that for a period of twenty days from the first publication of said notice, the City Clerk would receive expressions of approval or disapproval in writing, of the proposed extension of the boundaries of said City, from the resident freeholders of the territory proposed to be embraced therein, and

Whereas, more than twenty days have elapsed since the first publication of the said notice, and this being the first regular meeting of the Council after said expiration of the said twenty days, and

Whereas, the City Clerk has lain before the City Council all the communications received by him relative to the said proposed extensions of the boundaries and the City Council after considering the same, deems that the Boundaries should be extended, and the said resolution should be passed; Be it therefore

Resolved, that the Boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be extended so as to embrace and include the said Church Addition which is bounded and described as follows, to-wit: -

Beginning at the SE corner of Lot 12, Block 16 of the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Montana, thence east 145.2 feet to the SE corner of Church Addition, thence north 300 feet to the NE corner of said Church Addition, thence 145.2 feet to the NE corner of the Lot 1, Block 16 Original Townsite Polson, Montana, thence south 300 feet to the point of beginning, and according to plats filed herewith with the County Clerk and Recorder of Flathead County, Montana.

That all of said territory shall be attached to Precinct No. 2 of said city and shall be subject to the ordinances of the City of Polson.

This Resolution shall go into effect on the 7th day of May 1917.

Passed by the City Council this 7th day of May 1917.

Approved by the Mayor this 7th day of May 1917.
