

RESOLUTION NO. 20.

Whereas, the City Council of the City Of Polson, on the 21st day of May, 1917 duly and regularly passed and adopted a resolution declaring it to be to the best interest of the City of Polson and of the inhabitants of the Additions and Tracts hereinafter described that the boundaries of said City be extended so as to include within the Corporate Limits the said Additions and Tracts, and

Whereas, the City Council caused to be published in the Flathead Courier, a paper nearest to the said Additions and Tracts once a week for two successive weeks a notice of the effect that said resolution had been duly and regularly passed, and that for a period of twenty days from the first publication of said notice, the City Clerk would receive expressions of approval or disapproval in writing, of the proposed extension of the boundaries of said City, from the resident freeholders of the territory proposed to be embraced therein, and

Whereas, more than twenty days have elapsed since the first publication of the said notice, and this being the first regular meeting of the Council after that said expiration of the said twenty days and

Whereas, the City Clerk has lain before the City Council all the communications received by him relative to the said proposed extensions of the boundaries and the City Council after considering the same, deems that the boundaries should be extended, and the said resolution should be passed; Be it therefore

Resolved, that the boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be extended so as to embrace and include the said Additions and Tracts, which are bounded and described as follows, to-wit:--

All the platted tracts and parcels of land located in the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section Nine in Township Twenty-two north of Range Twenty west of the Montana Meridian, known and described as follows, to-wit:--Lewis Addition, Central Addition, and Pend de Oreille Addition, according to the recorded maps and plats thereof as now on file and of record in the Office of the County Clerk and Recorder of Flathead County, State of Montana,---Also the J. H. Cline tract described as follows, to-wit---Beginning at a point 56.7 feet South of the Southeast corner of Block Twenty-nine of the Original Townsite of Polson, Montana; thence south three hundred feet; thence west three hundred feet; then north three hundred feet; then east three hundred feet to the point of beginning-- Also the A. M Davidson tract described as follows: to-wit--- Beginning at a point sixty feet south of the Southeast corner of Block Seventeen of Pend de Oreille Heights Addition to the City of Polson, Montana; thence south 478.8 feet, thence west three hundred feet to the point of beginning---Also the J. L. McIntire tract described as follows, to-wit---Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Original Townsite of Polson, Montana; thence south 00 degrees 17' W., 752.6 ft., to the intersection of the north boundary line of "E" St., (Riverside Addition) 637.49 ft. to the intersection of the meander line of Flathead River; thence along meander line of Flathead River as follows;--N. 65 degrees 00' E. 290 ft.; thence north 27 degrees 45' E. 415.8 ft. thence north 34 degrees 30' east 322.75 ft. to the point of beginning, containing 4.09 acres, more or less of Lot 5, Sec. 4, T. 22N., R. 20 W., of the Principal Meridian, Montana ---- also the George O. Festvog Mission Range Power Company tract described as follows, to-wit:-- Beginning at meander corner of Fractional Sections 3 and 4, T. 22, N., R. 20 W., M. M. ; thence north 65 degrees West 392 feet; thence south 114.9 feet, thence south 81 degrees 18' E., 360 feet; thence north 4 feet to point of beginning, containing 0.454 acres more

or less, in Lot 3, Section 4, T. 22N., R. 20 W., M. M. ---Also Cramer's Subdivision to the City of Polson, Montana, comprising all of Lot Six of the supplemental plat of Section three in Township twenty-two north of Range twenty, west of the Montana Meridian, Montana containing 26.15 acres, more or less, according to the recorded map or plat thereof as on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk recorder of Flathead County, Montana.

This Resolution shall go into effect on the 2nd day of July, 1917.
