

RESOLUTION NO 23

A resolution <sup>of intention to construct</sup> ~~providing for~~ certain improvements within the boundaries of Special Improvement District Number 1, stating the character of the improvements to be made and the approximate estimate of the cost and expense thereof, and fixing the time when the City Council will hear objections to the making of these improvements.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson:

Section 1 - That the character of the improvements to be made in Special Improvement District Number 1 are hereby described as follows: the construction of concrete sidewalks and curbs with gutters on both sides of "D" Street west of Third Street to the alley or the west boundary line of the said District, also the grading and surfacing the said "C" and "D" Streets west of Third Street to the alley or the west boundary line of the said District.

Section 2 - That an approximate estimate of the cost and expense of the said improvements above described is \$1,500.00, and an estimate of the cost of engineering, inspection, etc., of the said improvements is the sum of \$75.00.

Section 3 - That the entire cost and expense of said improvements shall be assessed against all of the said special improvement district number 1 and each lot and parcel of land within said district shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets, alleys, avenues and public places.

Section 4 - That the cost and expense of making said improvements shall be assessed and paid for the same as all other improvements in Special Improvement District Number 1.

Section 5 - That warrants issued against Special Improvement District Number 1 Fund, for the payment of the cost and expense of the said improvements in Special Improvement District Number 1, shall be issued in the payment of the costs and expense of making said improvements.

Section 6 - That the special assessment to be levied upon and assessed against the property within said Special Improvement District Number 1 to pay the cost and expense of making said improvements may be paid in installments as herein provided.

~~Section 7 - That this Resolution shall be published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper published in said City of Polson, on March 21st, 1919.~~

Section 7 - That at any time within fifteen days after the date of the first publication of the passage of this Resolution any owner of property within said Special Improvement District Number 1 which may be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvement, may make and file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, a written protest against the proposed work, or against the extent, or both, and that the City Council will proceed to hear and pass upon all such protests at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 7th day of April, 1919, at seven-thirty o'clock P.M. of said day in the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 24

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, FLATHEAD COUNTY, MONTANA, TO CREATE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR IN THE CITY OF POLSON, FLATHEAD COUNTY, MONTANA FOR THE PURPOSE OF GRADING THE STREETS AND CONSTRUCTING SIDEWALKS, CURBS AND GUTTERS AND MAKING CERTAIN OTHER STREET IMPROVEMENTS AS HEREIN PROVIDED AND DESCRIBED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1 - That it is the intention of the City Council to create and establish in the City of Polson, Montana, Special Improvement District for the purpose of grading the streets and constructing side-walks, curbs and gutters along all that portion of the City of Polson, Montana, including all streets, alleys and intersections within the boundaries hereinafter particularly described.

Section 2 - The said Special Improvement District shall be known and designated as ~~as~~ SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR of the CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Section 3 - The boundaries of the said Special Improvement District Number Four of the City of Polson, Montana are hereby designated and described as follows, to-wit: -

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of the alley in block 20 and the line between lots 9 and 10 in block 20 of the Original Townsite of Polson; thence in a westerly direction on the line between lots 9 and 10 to the center of second street; thence west in the direction of a straight line forming the center of the alley in block 21 of the Original Townsite of Polson to the point of intersection with a line parallel to the west boundary line of First Street and Fifty feet west of the said west boundary line of First Street; thence north along the said parallel line for a distance of 173 feet; thence east to the west boundary line of First Street; thence northeasterly direction to the west corner post of lot 7 block 12 Original Townsite; thence in a Northeasterly direction along the boundary line between Block 12 and the Public Park to the point of intersection with the line forming the center line of the alley in block 12 of the Original Townsite of Polson; thence east along the center line of the alley in block 12 to the center of Second Street; thence South along the center of Second Street to the point of intersection with the line forming the boundary between lots 7 and 8 in block 13 of the Original Townsite of Polson; thence East along
