A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON FLATHEAD COUNTY MONTANA. TO CREATE SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 5 IN THE CITY OF POLSON FLATHEAD COUNTY, STATE OF MONTANA. FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANTING SHADE AND ORNAMENTAL TREES IN THE PARKINGS OF THE RESIDENTIAL SECTIONS OF SAID CITY AND CONSTRUCTING GUARD FOR THE PROTECTION AS HEREIN PROVIDED AND DESCRIBED.

Be it resolved by the city council of the City of Polson Montana, .

Section-1-

That it is the intention of the city council to create and establish in the City of Polson Montana, a special improvement district for the purpose of planting trees and constructing guards to protect the same.

Section -2-

The said Special Improvement District shall be known and designated as Special Improvement District Number 5 of the City of Polson Montana.

Section-3-

The boundaries of the said Special Improvement District Number 5 of the City of Polson, Montana are hereby designated and described as follows to-wit;

Beginning at the North-east corner of the Original Townsite of Polson thence due south on the east boundary line of Polson to the center line of G street, thence west on the center line of G street to the intersection of the center line of Birch Ave. thence north of E street, (Riverside Addition) thence in a north-easterly direction on the center line of E street to the intersection of the center line of Maple avenue, thence East on the center line of E street to the intersection of the West boundary line of the Original Townsite of Polson, thence N 00°17'E 412.6 feet to the Northwest corner of the Original Townsite of Polson, thence in a North-easterly direction on the meander lines of Flathead River and Flathead Lake to the point of beginning.

Section-4-

That the district included within the said boundaries is hereby declared to be the district benefited by the making of said improvements and that the property included within the said boundaries of said district is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvements.

Section-5-

Said lots or fractions thereof, to be benefited thereby and to be assessed, for said improvements are as follows, to-wit;

All lots in Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31 all of the Original Townsite and all lots in Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, of Riverside Addition, .

Provided however that lots wherein the said improvements have been or shall be made by owner according to plans and specifications on file shall be credited with its proportionate assessment as the same bears to the cost on the entire Improvement District No 5.

Section -6-

That the character of said improvements which are to be made in said Special Improvement District No.5 of the City of Polson Montana are as follows to-wit;;,

The furnishing and planting of shade and ornamental trees in the parking spaces on the various residential streets within the boundaries of the said district; and the furnishing and erecting of painted guard frames for said trees, as per plans and specifications.

Section -7-

The location of said proposed tree planting is as follows; Kootenai Ave.

From fourth street east to the east boundary line of the District, .

A Street

From the Alley in block two (2) East to the east boundary line of said District

B Street

From the lot line between Lots 9 and 10 of Block 6, and the lots 3 and 4 of block 9, east to the east boundary line of said district.

C Street

From the lot line between lots 9 and 10 Block 9, and lots 3 and 4 of Block 15, east to the east boundary of said district.

D. Street

From fifth street east to the boundary line of the District and from the alley in Blocks 13 and 20, West to First St.

E. Street

From fifth street east to boundary line of said District and from the Alley in Block 20 West to Birch Ave.

F. Street

From the east boundary to the west boundary of said District

G. Street

From the East boundary of said district west to the west boundary of said district, .

Cedar Ave.

From G street north to F street.

Maple Avenue

From G street north to E street.

Hawthorne Ave.

From G street north to E street.

First Street

From G street north to D street.

Second Street

From G street north to C street.

Third Street

From G street north to F street.

Fourth Street

From G street north to E street.

Fifth Street

From G street north to Kootenai Ave.

Section 8

That the entire cost of said improvements shall be assessed against the entire district, each lot or parcel of land within said district to be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets avenues alleys and public places; provided however that where said improvements shall be along any side street, or bordering or abutting upon the side of any corner lot of any block that the amount of the assessment against the property in said district, to defray the cost of said improvements shall be so assessed

that each square foot of the land embraced within any said corner lot, shall be r double the amount of the cost of said improvement that the square foot of any inside lot shall bear.

Section -9- That the total estimated cost and expense of making the said improvement is the sum of \$3,500.00 which is to be proportioned against each lot or fraction thereof, according to their area,.

Section -10- That the cost and expense of making said improvements shall be assessed and paid in the following manner to-wit That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvements shall be extended over a period of 4 years and paid in 4 annual installments or payments, the first of which shall be paid in the year 1919; deferred payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of 6 % per annum payable annually.

Section -11- That warrants issued against Special Improvement District Number 5 fund to be created for said Special Improvement District Number 5, shall be issued in the payment of the cost and expense of making said Improvements in the said Special Improvement District Number 5 and that such warrants shall be issued in denominations of \$100.00 or fraction, or multiples thereof.

Section -12- That the special assessment to be levied upon and assessed against the property within said Special Improvement District No. 5 to pay the cost and expense of making said improvements, may be paid in installments extending over a period of 4 years.

Section -12A- That the planting of shade and ornamental ##### trees in residence districts of said City of Polson shall not be ordered in until the streets avenues and parkings effected thereby shall have been graded to conform with the established grades of said City of Polson,.

Section -13- That at any time within fifteen days after the date of the first publication of notice of passage of the Resolution any owner of property within said District which will be assessed for the costs and expense of making said improvements, may make and file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana a written protest against the proposed work or against the extend or creation of said District, or both, and the City Council will proceed to hear and pass upon all such protests at a regular meeting to be held on the 5th day of May 1919. a 8 o'clock P.M. of the said day in the City Hall of the City of Polson Montana.
