

RESOLUTION NO. 28

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, FLATHEAD COUNTY MONTANA, TO CREATE SPECIAL SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 3 IN THE CITY OF POLSON, FLATHEAD COUNTY MONTANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SEWERS AS HEREIN PROVIDED AND DESCRIBED,.

Be It Resolved By The Council of The City Of Polson Montana:

Section 1.

That it is the intention of the City Council to create and establish in the City of Polson, Montana, a special Improvement District for the purpose of making and constructing sewers along all that portion of the City of Polson, Montana, including all streets, alleys and intersections within the boundaries hereinafter particularly described.

Section 2.

The said Special Improvement District shall be known and designated as Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 of the City of Polson, Montana.

Section 3. The Boundaries of said Special Sewer Improvement District number 3 of the City of Polson, Montana, are hereby designated and described as follows, to-wit; Beginning at the intersection of the center lines of "G" Street and Hawthorne Avenue; thence in a northerly direction on the center line of Hawthorne Avenue 747 feet to the intersection of the center line of "E" Street; thence in a westerly direction on the center line of "E" street 360 feet to the intersection of the center lines of Maple and Riverside Avenues; thence in a Southwesterly direction on the center line of Riverside Avenue 672.5 feet to the intersection of the center line of Birch Avenue; thence in a southerly direction on the center line of Birch Avenue 465.5 feet to the intersection of the center line of "G" Street; thence in an Easterly direction on the center line of "G" Street 976 feet to the intersection of the center line of Hawthorne Avenue, the same being the point of beginning,.

Section 4.

That the District included within said boundaries is hereby declared to be the District benefited by the making of said improvements and that the property included within the boundaries of said District is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvements,.

Section 5.

Said lots being benefitted by and assessed for the construction of said sewers are as follows, to-wit;

Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and 12 of Block 2.
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and 12 of Block 5.
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and 12 of Block 6.
 Each of the foregoing lots being of the dimensions of fifty feet in width by One Hundred and Forty feet deep,.
 Also the following lots;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and 12 of Block 4.
 Each of the foregoing lots being of the dimensions of Fifty feet in width by Ninety Seven and one half feet deep.
 Also the following irregular shaped lots;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5, and 6 of Block 3, being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 140 ft.
 Lot 7 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 60 ft. by 65.5 ft. by 134.5 by 140 ft.
 Lot 8 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 111.3 ft. by 134.5 ft.
 Lot 9 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 111.3 ft. by 134.5 ft.
 Lot 10 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 60 ft by 62.9 ft. by 65.5 ft. by 89.3 ft.
 Lot 11 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 40 ft. by 51.7 ft. by 56.09 ft. by 62.9 ft.
 Lot 12 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 39.7 ft. by 60 ft. by 60 ft. by 63.2 ft.
 Lot 13 Block 3, being of the dimensions of 39.7 ft by 59 ft. by 60 ft. by 65.5 ft.

Lot 14, Block 3, being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 59 ft. by 83.8 ft.

Lot 15 Block 3 being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 83.8 ft. by 108 ft.

Lot 16, Block 3, being of the dimensions of 50 ft. by 54.55 ft. by 108 ft. by 132.7 ft.

All of the foregoing Blocks and Lots being located in the Riverside Addition to the City of Polson, Flathead County, Montana.

Section 6.

That the character of the improvements which are to be made in said Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 are as follows, to-wit: The said improvement shall consist of a Combination Domestic and Storm, Gravity Sewer. Said un-treated sewage to be discharged into Flathead River at the North end of Birch Avenue. In the construction of said system, circular vitrified pipe ranging in size from six to ten inches in diameter, inside measure, will be employed.

Section 7.

The location of said proposed sewer is as follows;

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of "F" street with the center line of alley extending North and South through Blocks 2 and 6; thence in a Westerly direction along the center line of "F" Street 796 feet to the intersection of the center line of Birch Avenue, and on said center line produced, 230 feet to a point in Flathead River, - and

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the alley (running North and South through Blocks (2 and 6) with the north property line of Lots 1 and 12, Block 2, thence South along center line of said alley 680 feet to the intersection of the South property line of Lots 6 and 7, Block 6, - and

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the alley (running North and South through Block 5) with the South property line of Lots 6 and 7, Block 5; thence North along the center line of said alley 340 feet to the intersection of the center line of "F" Street, - and

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the alley (running North and South through Block 4) with the south property line of Lots 6 and 7, Block 4; thence North along the center line of said alley 340 feet to the intersection of the center line of "F" Street, - and

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the alley (running in a Southwesterly direction through Block 3) with the East property line of Lots 1 and 16, Block; thence in a Southwesterly direction along the center line of said alley 413 feet to the intersection of the center line of "F" Street.

Said proposed system to be provided with flush tanks, catchment basins, man holes, lamp holes, and any further necessary appliances, fittings or structures that may be required to insure proper operation and maintenance. The approximate quantities are as follows:

- 966 lineal feet of 10 inch vit. pipe
- 1773 " " 8 " " "
- 180 " " 6 " " "
- 60 " " 10 " riv. steel pipe.
- 2 Flush tanks
- 7 Man Holes
- 3 Lamp Holes
- 6 Catchment basins.

Section 8.

That the entire cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed against all of said Special Improvement Sewer District Number 3, and each lot or parcel of land within said District shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets, alleys, avenues and public places.

Section 9.

That the estimated cost and expense of making said improvement is the sum of \$117.00 per lot for each lot 50 feet in width by 140 feet in depth, and other lots in proportion thereto according to their area: - that the total estimated cost of making said improvement is \$6,669.00.

Section 10.

That the cost and expense of making said improvement shall be assessed and paid in the following manner, to-wit:

That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvement shall be extended over a period of eight years, and paid in eight annual installments or payments, the first of which shall be paid in the year 1921; deferred payments or installments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.

Section 11. That warrants issued against Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 fund, to be created for said Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 shall be issued in the payment of the costs and expense of making said improvements in said Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3, and that such warrants shall be issued in the denominations of \$100.00 or fraction or multiples thereof.

Section 12.

That the special assessment to be levied upon and assessed against the property within said Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3, to pay the cost and expense of making said improvement may be paid in installments extending over a period of eight years.

Section 13.

That at any time within fifteen days after the date of the first publication of notice of the passage of this Resolution, any owner of property within said district which will be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvement, may make and file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, a written protest against the proposed work, or against the extent, or creation of said district, or both, and that the City Council will proceed to hear and pass upon all such protests at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 26th day of July 1920, at eight o'clock P.M. of said day in the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana.
