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RESOLUTION NUMBER 30

NOTICE OF THE PASSAGE OF A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON TO CREATE A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT DESCRIBING THE GENERAL CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT PROPOSED, GIVING AN ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND THE TIME WHEN AND THE PLACE WHERE SAID CITY COUNCIL WILL HEAR AND PASS UPON ALL PROTESTS THAT MAY BE MADE AGAINST THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENT.

Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana;..

Section 1.

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, did on the 2nd, day of Aug. 1920. pass a resolution of its intention to create a special improvement district of the entire city of Polson, which improvement district will be known and described as Special Improvement District No. 6 of the City of Polson.

Section 2.

That the general character of the improvement to be made for the benefit of said Special Improvement District No. 6 of the City of Polson is hereby declared to be the construction, laying and installing of a gravity water supply system and the building of a pipe line to convey said water from a point 71° 47' east and 1183 feet distant from the Northeast corner of Section four in Township twenty-two North, Range nineteen West M.M. to the distribution reservoir of the city of Polson, Montana, a distance of 24,840 feet, and the obtaining of an adequate supply of pure mountain water,.

Section 3.

That the estimated cost for the making and installing of said improvement is the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

Section 4.

That the City Council of Polson, Montana, will be in session at the Council Chamber in the City Hall of the City of Polson on the 30th, day of August 1920, at eight o'clock P.M. of said day, at which time and place it will hear and consider all objections to the creation of said special improvement district,. That at any time between the passage of this resolution and the 30th, day of August 1920.

written protests against said work or the creation of said special improvement district may be made and filed with the City Clerk at his office in said Council chamber,.

Section 5.

That the boundaries of said Special Improvement District No.6 comprise the entire city of Polson, Montana, a more particular description being found in the resolution of intention heretofore passed and now on file with the City Clerk, reference to which is hereby made,.

Section 6.

That the district included within the boundaries of said Special Improvement District No.6 of the City of Polson is hereby declared to be the district and property benefited by the making of said improvement, and the property included within the boundaries of said Special Improvement District No.6 is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the cost and expense on making such improvement,.

Section 7.

That to defray the cost and expense of making the said improvements for said Special Improvement District No.6 of the City of Polson, the following method of assessment is hereby declared to be adopted by the City Council, to-wit; The cost and expense of the improvement proposed will be assessed against the entire district, each lot or parcel of land within said Special Improvement District No.6 of the city of Polson to be assessed for that part of the whole cost of completing said work which its area bears to the area of the entire district, exclusive of streets, alleys and public places,.

Section 8.

That the City Council further declare its intention to spread said assessment over a period of fifteen years, with the option to pay on or before, and to make the same payable in fifteen annual installments with interest on all deferred payments at the rate of six per cent per annum,.

Section 9.

That the City Clerk shall, upon the passage of this resolution, give notice of the passage thereof to the property owners in said proposed Special Improvement District No.6 in the form and manner as prescribed by law, and is hereby directed to cause a copy of said notice to be published in the Flathead Courier, a weekly newspaper printed and published in the City of Polson, in the manner and form as prescribed by law,.

---RESOLUTION NUMBER 31---

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND CREATING SPECIAL SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 3 IN THE CITY OF POLSON COUNTY OF FLATHEAD AND STATE OF MONTANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING SEWERS IN SAID DISTRICT, DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND THE PROPERTY TO BE ASSESSED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON MONTANA: WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson on the 6th, day of July A.D. 1920 duly and regularly passed and adopted Resolution No. 28 of the said City of Polson declaring its intention to create Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 of the City of Polson: and

Whereas, pursuant to the said Resolution the said City Council caused notice of the passage and adoption of said Resolution to be published in the Flathead Courier, a weekly newspaper published in the City of Polson, in the issues of said paper of July 8th and 15th, 1920, and for a period of more than 15 days immediately preceding the 26th, day of July 1920. and

Whereas, the said City Council caused notice of the passage and adoption of said Resolution, together with copy of said Resolution, to be posted by the City Clerk thruout the City on the 8th, day of July 1920, at three of the most public places within the City, to-wit one in the Post Office, one in the office of City Treasurer, and one in the office of the City Clerk: and

Whereas, pursuant to the said Resolution No. 28 the City Clerk of the City of Polson did on the 8th, day of July 1920, the same being the same day that said notice was first published in the Flathead Courier, mail to each and every person, firm or corporation, or agent of such person, firm or corporation, having property within the said proposed District, and directed to the last known address of said person, firm, corporation or agent, a notice of the passage and adoption of said Resolution of the intention to create Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3 of said City: and

Whereas, said notice was published, posted and mailed as aforesaid, describing the general character of the improvement proposed to be made in said District, the estimated cost thereof, and designating the time when and the place where, said Council of the City of Polson would hear and pass upon all protests made against the making of said improvement, or the creating of said district, and which said notice refers to said Resolution No. 28 on file in the office of the City Clerk, for a description of the boundaries of said Special Sewer Improvement District Number 3, and for plans specifications and details thereof: and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Polson has met in regular session at the time and place fixed and set by said Resolution, and the aforesaid notice, for the hearing of the protests against the making of said proposed improvement, and the creation of said proposed district and have heard and fully considered all such protests:

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that the City Council having heard and passed upon all protests made and delivered to the City Clerk of the City Council of the City of Polson, against the making of said proposed improvement and against the extent and creation of the proposed district within the time specified and provided in Resolution No. 28, and finding said protests to be insufficient, and that the protests are not made by the owners of more than one half of the area of the property to be assessed for said improvement,
