

RESOLUTION No. 37

A Resolution closing, vacating and discontinuing the alley running through Block No. Seventeen (17) in the original townsite of the city of Polson, Flathead County, Montana.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the city council of the City of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. It appearing to the satisfaction of the council that the clerk had given the necessary notice required by law and no one appearing to contest the petition heretofore presented by the Trustees of School District No. 23 for the closing, vacating and discontinuing of the alley through Block 17 of said city.

Section 2. It is hereby ordered by the City Council of the City of Polson, that the said alley running through Block 17 of said city be closed, vacated and discontinued.
