

RESOLUTION NO. 43

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF MONTANA TO CREATE A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 7, IN THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A BREAKWATER AS HEREINAFTER PROVIDED AND DISCRIBED.

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

## Section 1

That it is the intention of the City Council to create and establish in the City of Polson, Montana a special improvement district for the purpose of making and constructing a breadwater as hereinafter more particularly described.

## Section 2

That said special improvement district shall be known, when designated, as Special Improvement District Number 7, of the City of Polson, Montana.

## Section 3.

The boundaries of said special improvement district number 7 of the City of Polson are hereby designated and described as follows, to-wit: the boundary lines of the corporate limit of the City of Polson, Montana as shown by the official city records at the date of the passage of this resolution, and further described as follows:

The Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana and all the additions annexed thereto, to-wit: Riverside Addition; Church Addition; City Center Addition; Elevation Heights Addition; Grandview Addition; Polson Heights Addition; Central Addition; Lewis Addition; Lake Shore Add; Pend O'Reille Heights Addition; Cramer Sub-division; all of the said additions are included, together with the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Montana, including all acreage or tracts that may be within said corporate limits of said City.

## Section 4

That the distirct included within said boundaries is hereby declared to be the district benefited by the making of said improvements and that the property included within the boundaries of said district is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the costs and expenses of making said improvements.

## Section 5

The character of improvement to be made in said special improvement district Number 7 is as follows, to-wit:

Said improvement shall exist of a combination dock and breakwater of substantially the following construction: Commencing at a point two hundred fifty (250) feet due West of the bath house on the shore of Flathead Lake, City of Polson, Mont; thence by driving two rows of piling eight feet apart and sixteen feet distance from each other a distance of three hundred (300) feet due North, said piling to be planked on top, thus making a dock; thence piling every eight feet apart for a distance of six hundred (600) feet due East, said piling to be planked with three inch plank, between high and low water mark. An auxiliary breakwater immediately North ten feet consisting of piling every thirty-two (32) feet, making a log boom as an auxiliary protection. A floating dock eight feet wide shall be erected adjacent to and immediately South of the main breakwater, which floating dock shall be supported by thirty oil barrels and which dock shall be fastened to said piling in such a manner that the same may rise and fall with the water; all of which is more particularly shown by the plans and specifications on file with the City Cler.

## Section 6

The entire cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed against all of the real property contained within the corporate limits of the City of Polson and each lot or parcel of land within said District shall be assessed for that part of the whole cost which its area bears to the area of the entire District, exclusive of streets, alleys, avenues and public places.

## Section 7

That the estimated cost and expense of making said improvement is the sum of Two thousand three hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$2300.00)

## Section 8

That the assessment levied to defray the cost of said improvement shall be extended over a period of five years and paid in five annual installments, the first of which shall be paid in the year 1925 and deferred payments shall bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable annually.

## Section 9

That at any time within fifteen days after the first publication of the notice of the passage of this Resolution any owner of property within said District, which will be assessed for the costs and expense of making said improvement, may make and file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, a written protest against the proposed work, or against the extent or creation of said District, or both; and that the City Council will proceed to herein pass at a meeting of said City Council to be held on Monday, the 23rd day of March, 1925 at 8 o'clock P. M. of said day in the City Hall of the City of Polson, Montana.
