A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA LEVYING AND ASSESSING A TAX UPON ALL REAL ESTATE IN OIL SPRINK-LING DISTRICT NO. 1 IN THE CITY OF POLSON, TO DEFRAY THE COST

That, WHEREAS, the council of the city of polson, Montana did on the 6th day of June 1928 create an oil sprinkling

district No. 1, by a resolution duly passed upon said date, reference to which resolution is hereby made.

And, Whereas, the property in said oil sprinkling district is to be assessed to pay the cost of said sprinkling and that the estimated cost of the sprinkling in said district is hereby fixed at the sum of Eight Hundred (\$800.00) Dollars. And, WHEREAS, the council has and does hereby find, fix and determine that each and every of said several lots or parcels of land within said district has been specially benefited by said sprinkling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

That to defray the cost and expense of sprinkling said Oil Sprinkling District No. 1, there be and there is hereby levied and assessed a tax upon the property in said Oil Sprinkling District No. 1, amounting to the sum of \$800.00. That the description of each lot or parcel of land within said Oil Sprinkling District No. 1 with the name of the owner and the amount assessed against each lot or parcel of land is set forth in this Resolution and in the Special Improvement District and Warrant and Assessment Record to which reference is hereby made and which is made a part of this Resolution.

AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, That the council of the city of Polson Montana will be in session at the city hall in the city of Polson Montana on Monday June 18th 1928 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on said day at which time and place the city council will hear objections to the final adoption of this resolution. That the clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to publish at least once in a newspaper published in the city of Polson, Montana a notice signed by the clark stating that this resolution levying the special assessment to defray the cost of said sprinkling is on file in his office subject to inspection for a periof of five days; that said notice shall state the time and place at which objection to the final adoption of this resolution will be heard by the council and that said notice shall be published at least five days before the time set for hearing objections to the final adoption of this resolution. That the list of the lots or parcels of lands assessed with the name of the owner and the amount levied thereon is herein set forth as follows: - (See Special Improvement District
