

RESOLUTION NO/48 a

A RESOLUTION CREATING AN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT to be KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT No. 2 DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES OF SAID DISTRICT AND GIVING THE AREA THEREIN AND THE PROPERTY AFFECTED THEREBY.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY the City council of the city of Polson, Montana that an oil sprinkling district to be known and designated as Oil Sprinkling District No. 2 is hereby created.

Section 2. That the boundaries of said oil sprinkling district and the area embraced therein and the property to be assessed therefor and the streets to be sprinkled under this resolution border upon the following ~~ax~~described lots and blocks in said city:-

Section 3. That the district including the property above described is hereby declared to be the district benefited by the oiling of said streets, alleys and public places and is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the cost and expense thereof; that the property to be assessed for the same is all set out in Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. That the method adopted for paying for said oil sprinkling shall be on an area basis.
