A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, LEVYING AND ASSESSING A TAX UPON ALL REAL ESTATE IN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 2 IN THE CITY OF POLSON, TO DEFRAY THE COST THEREOF.

THAT, Whereas, the council of the city of polson, Montana, did, on the 1st day of April 1929 create an oil sprinkling district No. 2, by a Resolution duly passed upon that date, reference to which resolution is hereby made.

AND, WHEREAS, the property in said Oil Sprinkling District is to be assessed to pay the cost of said sprinkling and that the estimated cost of the sprinkling in said district is hereby fixed at the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars.

AND, WHEREAS the council has and does hereby find, fix and determine that each and every of said several lots or parcels of land within said district has been specially benefited by said sprinkling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

THAT TO DEFRAY THE COST AND expense of sprinkling said Oil Sprinkling District No. 2 there be and there is hereby levied and assessed a tax upon the property in said Oil Sprinkling District No. 2 amounting to the sum of \$900.00. That the description of each lot or parcel of land within said Oil Sprinkling District No. 2 with the name of the owner and the amount assessed against each lot or parcel of land is set forth in this Resolution and in the Special Improvement District and Assessment Record to which reference is hereby made and which is made a part of this Resolution.

AND IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the council of the city of Polson Montana, will be in session at the City Hall in the city of Polson, Montana on Wednesday the 12th day of June, 1929 at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on said day, at which time and place the city council will hear objections to the final adoption of this Resolution.

That the clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to publish at least once in a newspaper published in the city of Polson, Montana a notice signed by the clerk, stating that this Resolution levying the special assessment to defray the cost of said sprinkling is on file in his office, subject to inspection for a period of five days; that said notice shall state the time and place at which objections to the final adoption of this Resolution will be heard by the council and that said notice shall be published at least five days before the time set for hearing objections to the final adoption of this Resolution.

Passed by the city council and approved by the Mayor this 3rd day of July, 1929.

THAT, WHEREAS, THE above entitled Resolution No. 50, signed by the Mayor and clerk of said city was filed in the office of the clerk of said city on June 3, 1929 and has ever since been on file in said office subject to inspection and the clerk having given notice of the passage and filing of said Resolution by publishing a notice in the Flathead Courier a newspaper published in said city at least five days before the date stated therein for hearing objections to the final adoption of said Resolution, the said time of hearing being not less than five days after the date of publication of said notice and no owner of property within said Oil Sprinkling District No. 2 or any other person appearing to object to the adoption of said Resolution and the assessment therein provided for, and it appearing to the council that the sprinkling of said district was necessary and the cost thereof should be assessed as in said Resolution provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above entitled and foregoing Resolution be and the same is hereby adopted and the special assessment therein provided for be and the same are hereby levied and assessed accordingly and will become delinquent on November 30th, 1929 at 6 P.M.
