RESOLUTION NO. 64

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON SO AS TO INCLUDE MICHEL ADDITION THEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, on the 3rd day of August, 1936, duly and regularly passed a resolution proposing to extend the corporate limits of the City of Polson so as to include Michel Addition therein, and declaring it to be to the best interests of the City of Polson and the inhabitants thereof and of the inhabitants of said territory or parcel of land, as aforesaid, that the boundaries of the City of Polson shall be extended so as to include the same within the corporate limits thereof, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has caused to be published in the Flathead Courier, the newspaper published nearest said Addition, at least once a week for two successive weeks, a notice to the effect that this resolution has been duly and regularly passed and that for a period of twenty days after the publication of said notice, the City Clerk will receive expressions of approval or disapproval in writing of the proposed extension of the boundaries of the City of Polson from freeholders of the territory proposed to be embraced therein, and the property holders therein to be notified in writing, and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received no communications in writing relative to the proposed extensions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson that the boundaries of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be extended, and the same are hereby extended, so as to include within the corporate limits of said City all of that portion of the Angeline Michel Gingras, formerly Angeline Michel, Indian Allotment in Section Four (4), in Township Twenty-two (22) North, Range Twenty (20) West M. M. lying south of the north boundary line of "C" Street.
