

RESOLUTION NO 75

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO 12, AND DEFINING THE BOUNDRIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COST THEREOF:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POLSON COUNCIL, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

THAT An oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO 12 is hereby created.

THAT The boundries of said oil sprinkling district No 12 are and shall be such as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson, Montana, including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border towit:-

SAME AS OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT No 11

That The estimated cost of oiling said district is the sum of \$1,500.00

THAT An emergency exists and it is necessary immediately for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson that this resolution shall take affect immediately upon its passage and approval.

That All re solutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Passed by the council and approved by the Mayor this 4th day of May, 1942.

ORDINANCE 206

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD OF OILING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO 12, AND OF PAYING FOR SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the city council of the city of Polson, Lake County, Montana, that:-

Section 1. That all of the streets included within OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO 12 shall be oiled during the summer of 1942 by forces employed by the city.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all the property, exclusive of parks and public places, embraced within such sprinkling district on an area basis.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
