## ORDINANCE NO.209

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD OF OILING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO 13, AND OF PAYING FOR SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON. LAKE COUNTY? MONTANA? to-wit;

Section 1. That all of the streets included within  $^{\rm O}$ il Sprinkling District No. 13 shall be oiled during the summer season of 1945 by forces employed by the City.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of the property, exclusive of parks and public places, embraced within such sprinkling district on an area basis.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exicts and it as necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## RESOLUTION NO. 77

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO.14, AMD DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COST THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY. OF .POLSON; LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

Section 1. That an oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO.14, is hereby created.

Section 2. That the boundaries of said oil sprinkling district No. 14 are and shall be such as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson, Montana, including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border, to-wit:

All of Blk 1, all of Blk 2, all of Blk 3, all of Blk 4, all of Blk 5, all of Blk 6, Lots 1 to 7 inc. Blk 7, lots 6 to 12 inc. Blk 8, all of Blk 9, all of Blk 10, all of Blk 11, all of Blk 12, all of Blk 13, all of Blk 14, all of Blk 15, all of Blk 16, all of Blk 17, all of Blk 18, all of Blk 19, all of Blk 20, all of Blk 21, all of Blk 22, all of Blk 23, all of Blk 24, all of Blk 25, all of Blk 26, all of Blk 27, all of Blk 28, all of Blk 29, all of Blk 30, and of Blk 31 of the Original Townsite of Polson.

All of Blk 1, all of Blk 2, Lot 1 and Lots 7 to 16 inc. Blk 3, all of Blk 4, all of Blk 5, all of Blk 6, and all of Blk 7 of Riverside Addition.

All of Blk 1, all of Blk 2, all of Blk 3, Lots 1 to 6 in Blk 4, Lots 1 to 6 in Blk 5, Lots 7 to 12 in Blk 8, Lots 7 to 12 in Blk 9, Lot 12 of Blk 4 and Lots 1 and 12 Blk 7 of Cramer Sub-division to Polson.

Lots 4 to 7 inc. in Blk 1, Lots 5 to 12 inc. in Blk 2, all of Blk 5, Lots 1 to 4 in Blk 6, Lots 1 to 7 in Blk 8, Lots 6 and 7 in Blk 11, Lakeshore Addition to Polson.

All of Blk 1 of Church Addition to Polson.

Lots 1 to 6 inc. Blk 1, Lots 1 to 6 inc. Blk 2, Lots 1 to 6 inc. Blk 3, and Lots 1 to 4 inc. Blk 4 of Lewis Addition to Polson.

Lots 1 to 6 inc. Blk 1, Lots 1 to 8 inc. Blk 2, and the Polson Flour Mills Blk in Central Addition to Polson.

Roman Catholic Bishop (Church) and the Nothern Pacific Ry. Co. property in Center Addition to Polson.

Lots 1, 2, 3, Blk 2 Tract 8, and one lot of Geo. Elmore on "G" St. in Michel Addition to Polson.

The McIntire Tracts adjoining Riverside Addition.

Section 3. That the estimated cost of oiling said district is the sum of #3200.00

Section 4. That an emergency exists and it is necessary immediately for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson that this RESCLUTION shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 5. That all resolutions or part of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
