

RESOLUTION NO 81

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14-A AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA.

Section 1. That an oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as Oil Sprinkling District No 14-A is hereby created.

Section 2. That the boundaries of said Oil Sprinkling District No 14-A are and shall be such as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson, Montana, including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border, to-wit:

All of Block 1, all of Block 2, all of Block 3, all of Block 4, all of Block 5, all of Block 6, Lots 1 to 7 inc. Block 7, Lots 6 to 12 inc. Block 8, Block 9, Block 10, Block 11, Block 12, Block 13, Block 14, Block 15, Block 16, Block 17, Block 18, Block 19, Block 20, Block 21, Block 22, Block 23, Block 24, Block 25, Block 26, Block 27, Block 28, Block 29, Block 30, and Block 31 of the original townsite of Polson.

All of Block 1, All of Block 2, Lots 1 and Lots 7 to 16 inc. Block 3, all of Blocks 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Riverside addition of the City of Polson.

Lots 1 to 5 inc. Block 1, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 2, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 3, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 4, Lots 7 to 12 inc. Block 5, Lots 1 to 6 inc. Block 6, Lot 12, Block 6, Lots 1 to 7 inc. Lots 4 to 7 inc. Block 1, Lots 5 to 12 inc. Block 2, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 5, Lots 1 to 8 inc. Block 6, Lots 1 to 5 inc. Block 7, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 8, Lots 1 to 12 inc. Block 11, and Lots 5 to 8 inc. Block 12 of Lake Shore addition to the City of Polson.

Section 3: That the estimated costs of oiling said district is in the sum of \$6500.00

Section 4; That an emergency exists and it is necessary immediately for the preservation of peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 5. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
