## ORDINANCE NO. 218

'AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD FOR OILING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OILING DISTRICT OR SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14 B , PAYING FOR THE SAME AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Section 1; That all the streets included within sprinkling district No  $14~\mathrm{B}$  shall be oiled during the summer seasom of 1948, by forces employed by the city.

Section 2; That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of said property, exclusive of public parks and public places, embraced within such sprinkling district upon an area basis.

Section 3; Whereas an emergency exists, and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that this ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL DISTRICT NO. 14 B AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

Section 5: That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
