Resolution No. 100

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL DISTRICT NO. 14-C AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, County of Lake, Montana.

Section 1: That an oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as oil sprinkling district No. 14-C is hereby created.

Section 2; That the boundaries of said oil sprinkling district No. 14-C are and shall be as to include all of the area or that portion of the city of Polson including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

All of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Lots 2 to 12 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, all of Blocks 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31 of the Original Townsite of Polson.

Section 4: That the estimated cost of oiling said district shall be the sum of \$6,000.00.

Section 5: That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict are hereby repealed.
