

5. The City Clerk shall cause suitable ballots to be prepared for use at said election, and shall distribute the same to the judges of election in the respective precincts, together with the poll books supplied by the County Clerk and other necessary and proper election supplies, which ballots shall read substantially as follows:

FOR the City of Polson, Montana, issuing and selling its negotiable Revenue Bonds in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), to be payable during a period of twenty years from the date of their issuance, and using the proceeds thereof to finance the acquisition, purchase, construction, reconstruction, improvement, betterment, and extension of an undertaking, consisting of its water system, and all parts thereof and appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, supply and distribution systems, reservoirs, and dams, all in conformity with Session Laws of Montana of 1939, Chapter 126, as amended, such bonds and the interest thereon to be payable solely out of net income and revenues to be derived from rates and charges for the use of the facilities provided by the undertaking and not to incur any obligation for the payment of which taxes may be levied except to pay for services provided by the undertaking to the City itself.

AGAINST the City of Polson, Montana, issuing and selling its negotiable Revenue Bonds in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), to be payable during a period of twenty years from the date of their issuance, and using the proceeds thereof to finance the acquisition, purchase, construction, reconstruction, improvement, betterment, and extension of an undertaking, consisting of its water system, and all parts thereof and appurtenances thereto, including, but not limited to, supply and distribution systems, reservoirs, and dams, all in conformity with Session Laws of Montana of 1939, Chapter 126, as amended, such bonds and the interest thereon to be payable solely out of net income and revenues to be derived from rates and charges for the use of the facilities provided by the undertaking and not to incur any obligation for the payment of which taxes may be levied except to pay for services provided by the undertaking to the City itself.

6. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to furnish to the judges and clerks of election all other necessary and convenient facilities and supplies for said election and the returns thereof. Resolution No. 103

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL DISTRICT NO. 14-E AND DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, County of Lake, Montana:

Section 1: That an oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as Oil District No. 14-E is hereby created.

Section 2: That the boundaries of said Oil District No. 14-E are and shall be as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson including the Streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

All of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Lots 2 to 12 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, all of Blocks 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31 of the Original Townsite of the City of Polson.

All of Blocks 1 and 2, Lots 1 and 7 to 16 inclusive in Block 3, all of Blocks 4, 5, 6, 7 of Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 6 and 7, Block 2; Lots 1 and 12 of Block 3; Lots 6 and 7 of Block 4; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive of Block 5, Lots 1 and 12 of Block 6, Lots 6 and 7 of Block 7, Lots 5 and 6 of Block 10, Lots 1 and 12 of Block 11, Lots 7 to 12 inclusive of Block 12, Lots 7 to 11 inclusive of Block 13, Lots 1 to 6 inclusive of Block 14, Lots 6 and 7 of Block 15, Lots 6 and 7 of Block 18, Lots 1 and 12 of Block 19 of the Grandview Addition to the City of Polson.

Section 3. That an emergency exists and it is necessary immediately for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 4: That the estimated cost of oiling said district shall be the sum of \$6,000.00.

Section 5: That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Resolution No. 104

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14-F, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, County of Lake, Montana:

Section 1: That an oil sprinkling district to be known and designated as Oil Sprinkling District No. 14-F is hereby created, at a cost of approximately \$2,500.00.

Section 2: That the boundaries of said oil sprinkling district shall be such as to include all of the area of the City of Polson, Montana, including the streets and avenues upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

Lots 2 to 6, inclusive, Block 3, Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 7 to 11 inclusive in Block 4, Lots 7 to 12 inclusive in Block 5, All of Block 6, Lots 2 to 11 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 2 to 6 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 9, Cramer addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 8 to 12 inclusive in Block 5, Lots 5 to 8 inclusive in Block 6, all of Block 7, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 8 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive in Block 11, Lots 1 to 4 inclusive in Block 12, Lakeshore Addition to the City of Polson.
