

hundreds corresponding with the number of streets, to the eastern boundary of the platted portion of the city, which shall be known and designated as Ninth Street East.

Commencing on the streets running east and west where they intersect with Main Street on the west side, with number 1 on the south side and number 2 on the north side, thence running west allowing one number to each twenty-five (25) foot lot in the business district, and one number to each fifty (50) foot lot in the residential district; commencing with the number of hundreds corresponding to each street for each block on the east side of each respective block, so numbering each block to westerly limits of the platted portion of the city, which shall be known and designated, as Sixth Street West.

Third -- All buildings shall be numbered according to the streets or avenues said buildings shall face.

Section 2. The street commissioner shall designate the numbers of all houses and business places now or hereafter built, with its proper number as soon as completed and when any house is not correctly numbered, or not numbered at all, the street commissioner shall give such house its proper number and require the same to be on such house in a conspicuous place next to the street at the expense of the owner.

Section 3. In case any owner, occupant or agent having been requested as aforesaid by the street commissioner shall refuse or neglect for ten days to number a house as required, or shall number or attempt to number such house otherwise than in conformity with this article, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00, and when such fine is paid the street commissioner shall cause such house to be correctly numbered at the expense of the City of Polson.

Section 4. By reason of the fact that an emergency exists, effecting the police protection or safety, health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 5. All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL DISTRICT NO. 14-G, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATING THE COSTS THEREOF.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, County of Lake, Montana:

Section 1: That an oil sprinkling district, to be known and designated as Oil District No. 14-G, is hereby created.

Section 2: That the boundaries of said Oil District No. 14-G are and shall be as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

All of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Lots 2 to 12 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, all of Blocks 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31 of the Original Townsite of the City of Polson.

All of Blocks 1 and 2, Lots 1 and 7 to 16 inclusive in Block 3, all of Blocks 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Section 4: That the estimated cost of oiling said district shall be the sum of \$6,000.00.

Section 5: That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Resolution No. 109

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14-H, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND ESTIMATE THE COSTS THEREOF.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Polson, County of Lake, Montana:

Section 1: That an oil sprinkling district to be known and designated as Oil Sprinkling District No. 14-H is hereby created, at a cost of approximately \$2,500.00.

Section 2: That the boundaries of said oil sprinkling district shall be such as to include all of the area of the City of Polson, including the streets and avenues upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

Lots 2 to 6 inclusive, Block 3, Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 7 to 11 inclusive in Block 4, Lots 7 to 12 inclusive in Block 5, All of Block 6, Lots 2 to 11 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 2 to 6 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 9, Cramer Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 8 to 12 inclusive in Block 5, Lots 5 to 8 inclusive in Block 6, all of Block 7, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 8 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive in Block 11, Lots 1 to 4 inclusive in Block 12, Lakeshore Addition to the City of Polson.
