A RESOLUTION CREATING SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 15 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY THEREOF, AS STATED AND PROVIDED IN THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION UNDER DATE OF JUNE 4th, 1951, PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF ASSESSMENT, PROVIDING FOR NOTICE AND CALL FOR BIDS, AND FORM AND SALE OF BONDS.

WHEREAS: The City Council of the City of Polson, did on the 4th day of June, 1951, pass a Resolution of Intentions to create a Special Improvement District within the City of Polson, the same being resolution No. 110, and the district so proposed to be created being No. 15.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON,

LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

That said Special Improvement District Number 15 be and the same Section 1.

is hereby created.

Section 2. Upon the passage and approval of this Resolution Creating Special Improvement District Number 15, the City Clerk of the City of Polson is hereby directed to call for bids for work to be done in said Special Improvements, subject to the sale of said bonds, referring to the plans and specifications on file in his office, which notice shall be in conformity with the law as stated in Sec. 11-2209 R.C.M. 1947.
