NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That the City Council of the City of Polson, will at the City Council Hall, in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, on Tuesday, the 24 day of July, 1951, at 8 o'clock P.M., receive bids for the construction work to be done in Special Improvement District Number 15, in the City of Polson, the same being excavation of a certain street and avenue, filling and refilling, basing and rebasing, and graveling, and all work including subdrainage, the same excluding the oiling, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in and pertaining to the same, in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars.

All proposals or bids must be in writing, filed with the City Clerk of the City of Polson, on or before the day and date above mentioned, and be accompanied by a certified check payable to the City of Polson, in a sum not less than 10 per cent of the bid submitted.

RESOLUTION NO. 115

A RESOLUTION CREATING SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 16, OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY THEREOF, AS STATED AND PROVIDED IN THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION UNDER DATE OF JUNE 4th, 1951, PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF ASSESSMENT, CALL FOR BIDS, AND FORM AND SALE OF BONDS.

WHEREAS: The City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, did on the 4th day of June, 1951, pass a Resolution of Intentions, number 111, to create Special Improvement District number 16, within the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana.

AND WHEREAS: Said Resolution of Intentions aforesaid among other matters and things set forth the general character and nature of the work and improvements proposed within said intended district, defined the boundary of said district, set forth the proposed manner of assessment, and therein directed that the City Clerk of the City of Polson give notice to all property owners, persons, firms, corporations or agents thereof, in manner and form as by law provided.

AND NOW: On this date, to-wit, the 2nd day of July, 1951, the same being a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Polson, at the City Hall of said City, and at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M., being the time and place as provided for the hearing upon said Resolution of Intentions aforesaid in and pertaining to the creation of said district, the matter came on for hearing before the said City Council of the said City of Polson.

AND NOW, FURTHER: It appears to the satisfaction of the City Council of the City of Polson, that due and legal notice has been given of the passage of said Resolution of Intentions to create Special Improvement District No. 16, as evidenced by the affidavit of publication of Notice to Property Owners, and as further evidenced by the affidavit of mailing by the City Clerk of the City of Polson of said Notice to Property Owners to property owners, persons, firms, corporations or agents thereof having or owning property within said proposed district, and that said Resolution of Intentions aforesaid, and the Notice to Property Owners are each and both proper in form and sufficient.

And it further appears to the satisfaction of the City Council of the City of Polson, that less than 40 per cent of the property owners have made objection to the creation of said district, either as to the character of the improvements or the extent of said district, and that no objections have been made or filed in any manner or form.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

Section 1. That said Special Improvement District Number 16 be and the same is hereby created.

Section 2. That the property so included within said proposed district, and as now created is as follows:

That portion of First Street East, from the North edge of the oil paving on Hi-Way 93, extending north to First Avenue, being one block and approximately 15 feet.

The property included in said District aforesaid, and the boundary thereof is determined by the inclusion of each and all of the following lots, parts and

portions thereof in the following blocks, to-wit:

Lots One, Two, Three, Four, Five and Six in Block Five.

Lots Six and Seven in Block Six,

all in the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder in and for Lake County.

Section 3. That the character and nature of the improvements to be done and effected within said Special Improvement District are fully set out and described in the Resolution of Intentions herein referred, Number 111, now on file with the City Clerk of the City of Polson, and reference to the same is hereby made for further particulars.

Section 4. That the manner of assessment for the payment of said improvements shall not be in excess of the sum of \$125.00 per 25 foot frontage, as the said property herein described fronts or abutts upon the avenue described which sum shall include the pro rate share of the portion of an intersection, payment to be extended over a period of 10 years, in equal annual installments, with interest not to exceed 6% per annum, reserving the right on the part of the City to pay or liquidate the same at any time.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

Section 1. That Special Improvement Bonds in the sum of \$3000.00 be issued and offered for sale against said Special Improvement Number 16, now created, which said bonds are to be paid by the special assessments herein referred to and herein provided, said bonds to be paid over a period of 10 years, reserving to the City the right to pay and discharge said bonds at any time, and the form of bond as stated and provided in Section 11-2231 is hereby adopted, said bonds to be in denomination of \$100.00, or \$1000.00 each as the City Council may determine, and bear interest at a rate not to exceed 6% per annum.

Section 2. Upon the passage and approval of this Resolution Creating Special Improvement District Number 16, the City Clerk of the City of Polson is hereby directed to call for bids for the work to be done in said Special Improvement District, subject to the sale of the bonds, referring to the plans and specifications on file in his office, which said notice shall in all respects conform to the law as stated in Section 11-2209 R.C. M. 1947.

NOTICE OF SALE OF SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BONDS.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: By the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, that said City Council will on the 6th day of August, 1951, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. at the City Council Chambers, Polson, Montana, sell to the highest and best bidder for cash, bonds of Special Improvement District No. 16 of said City of Polson, Montana, in the amount of \$3000.00 in form as by law provided, for the purpose of making improvements in said Special Improvement District.

A RESOLUTION CREATING SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 10, OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY BY REFERENCE AS STATED IN RESOLUTION OF INTENTIONS NO. 112, UNDER DATE OF JUNE 4th, 1951, PROVIDING FOR MANNER OF ASSESSMENT, CALL FOR BIDS, AND FORM AND SALE OF BONDS.

WHEREAS: The City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, did on the 4th day of June, 1951, pass a Resolution of Intentions, Number 112, to create a Special Improvement Sanitary Sewer District Number 10, within the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana.

Section 1. That Special Improvement Bonds in the sum of \$59,400.00 be issued and offered for sale against the Special Improvement Sanitary Sewer District No. 10, now created, which said bonds are to be paid by and through the special assessments above mentioned, said bonds to be paid over a period of 20
