RESOLUTION NO. 118

WHEREAS: The City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, did on the 8th day of June 1951, pass Resolution No. 113, which provided for the calling of a Special Election, at and within the City of Polson, Montana, in all the wards and precincts thereof, that the qualified electors therein might vote upon the question of issuing bonds of the City of Polson, Montana, in the sum of \$75,000.00, bearing interest at the rate not to exceed 6% per annum, payable semi-annually, during a period of 20 years, and redeemable at the option of the City 5 years from date of issue, which resolution fixed the date of said election aforesaid for Wednesday the 11th of July, 1951, between the hours of 12 o'clock Noon and 8 o'clock P.M. of said day; and the said bonds to be issued for the purpose of securing funds to build and construct a sewer system to be used for sanitary and other drainage purposes for the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana.

AND WHEREAS: It now appears that due and legal notice has been given of the time and place of said election in manner and form, and in all respects, as by law provided, and proof thereof being on file with the City Clerk of the City of Polson.

AND WHEREAS: It appears from the returns of said election, and the record on file in and pertaining to the same, that said Special Election was legally had and conducted according to the notices thereof and pursuant to the Laws of the State of Montana, and that at said election 433 were cast by registered electors duly qualified to vote; that 408 votes were cast in favor of said Bond issue; and that 25 votes were cast against the same; and that there were 784 eligible voters eligible to vote at such election and that more than 40 per cent did in fact so vote.

AND WHEREAS: It appears conclusively that not any one, taxpayer, City, Bidder, or otherwise, have been or will be prejudiced by the passing of this resolution at this time, or by any statutory irregularity, if any there may be, in these proceedings, but to the contrary it appears that it will be to the best interests of the City of Polson, Montana, and the citizens thereof, that this resolution be now passed.

AND WHEREAS: Through and by virtue of said election the City Council of the City of Polson has been authorized and empowered to issue, negotiate and sell such bonds, and the indebtedness created by said bond issue, together with all other indebtedness of the City of Polson, Montana, will not exceed 5 per cent of the value of the taxable property of said City as ascertained by the last completed assessment for State and County taxes, and does not exceed its constitutional limitations, and that the said City Council now has full authority to issue, negotiate and sell said bonds, for the purpose specified, and in the sum specified.

NOW THEREFORE; BE IT RESOLVED that under and by virtue of the law in the premises and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 23, Title 11, R.C.M. 1947, and all acts supplemental and amendatory thereof, the City Council of the City of Polson, does hereby proceed to issue Coupon Bonds of the said City of Polson, Montana, in the amount of \$75,000.00, in order to obtain funds, and for the purpose of building and constructing a sewer system, to be used for sanitary and other drainage purposes for and within the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana; such said bonds to be issued as of the 1st day of September, 1951, and payable on the amortization plan or serially over a period of 20 years, and redeemable at the option of the City of Polson, 5 years from date of issue and on any interest payment date thereafter before maturity, and to bear interest at a rate not to exceed 6 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the sale and issue of such bonds preference will be given to amortization bonds, and if amortization bonds are issued, the entire issue may be put into one bonds, or be divided into several bonds as the purchaser may indicate in his bid and as the City Council may determine at the time of sale. AND if it be found necessary to issue serial bonds they shall be in the amount of \$3,800.00 each, except the last bond, which will be in the sum of \$2,800.00; the sum of \$3,800.00 of said serial bonds will become due and

payable on the 1st day of Sept., 1952, and a like sum each year thereafter, on the same date until the said bonds are fully paid, except the last payment in the sum of \$2800.00 and interest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Polson, the City Clerk of said City and the Treasurer thereof, or such other officers as are required by law so to do, are hereby authorized and empowered to sign and execute said bonds and affix the corporate seal of the City thereto, and to sign the coupon bonds attached to each of said bonds, provided that the facsimiles of the signature of said officers may be affixed to the coupons when so recited in the bond.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the City Council of the City of Polson, meet at the Council Chambers, at the City Hall in the said City of Polson, on the 20th day of August, 1951, at 8 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of receiving and considering bids on the said bonds; and that the City Clerk of the City of Polson, is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the sale of said bonds in the form, manner and time as required by the laws of the State of Montana, in reference thereto, and that such notice be published in the Flathead Courier, a newspaper printed and published, and of general circulation, in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, and that such publication be for a period of four consecutive and successive weeks preceding the date of said, that is five publications, in said weekly paper.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk of the City of Polson, is hereby directed to furnish the Secretary of the State Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Montana, Helena, Montana, at least 15 days before the date of sale, a copy of the Notice of Sale of said bonds as advertised, also a complete transcript of all of the proceedings had with reference to the issuance of said bonds, together with such information and certificates as the said Secretary may require, and at the same time said clerk shall furnish the Attorney General of the State of Montana, Helena, Montana, with a certified copy of the record in connection with the proceedings leading to the issuance of said bonds and request his report as to the validity of the same as by law required.

ORDINANCE #234

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO PROHIBIT HEAVY TRAFFIC, TRANSPORT UPON CERTAIN STREETS, AND AUTHORIZING MAKING OF REGULATIONS, POSTING AND SIMILIAR MATTERS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF HIS ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the city council of the city of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. The use of heavy transport, heavy vehicles is prohibited upon any street or streets in the city of Polson, during unfavorable road bed conditions, or othertimes as determined by the city council, by posting notices or signs at observable and convenient places on or at said street or streets.

Section 2. The city council may re route heavy traffic from any street or streets or alleys as conditions may require, upon posting notices or signs on or at said street.

Section 3. The peace, welfare and well being of the inhabitants of said city and of said streets create an emergency calling for the immediate enactment of this ordinance and by virtue thereof this ordinance becomes effective immediately.

Section 4. Any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 5. The street commissioner, police or other representative of the city shall post such notices or signs as directed by the City council.

Section 6. Any violation of this ordinance, after posting of signs or notice shall subject the offender, upon conviction to a fine of not less than \$1, or \$100 fine or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
