

Section 5. Section 6. That upon due and proper execution of said bonds and the interest coupons attached and proper registration of the same by the City Treasurer, they be delivered to Grande & Co., Inc. upon payment of the price bid for the same together with accrued interest to date of delivery.

Section 7. That such parts of Resolution No. 116 passed and approved July 2, 1951, and any other resolutions or parts of resolutions which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 235

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING "SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT REVOLVING FUND" IN AND FOR THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, (LAKE COUNTY), MONTANA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established and created a "SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT REVOLVING FUND" Within and for the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, in order to secure prompt payment of special improvement district bonds issued in payment of improvements made, or to be made in Special Improvement District No. 10 in said City of Polson, Montana, and the interest due and to become due on said bonds aforesaid, which bonds are for the amount of \$59,400.00, with interest at the rate of 5 3/4 percent per annum, payable semi-annually, which said revolving fund shall be maintained by a levy upon all of the taxable property within the said City of Polson, Montana, in such amount and to such extent as is required, and for such time as may be required in order that said bonds, together with interest shall be fully paid in accordance with the terms, conditions, tenor and affect thereof.

SECTION 2. That for the purpose of maintaining and providing funds for such revolving fund the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana,

1. May in its discretion, from time to time, transfer to the revolving fund from the general fund of the City such amount or amounts as may be deemed necessary, which amount or amounts so transferred shall be deemed and considered, and shall be, loans from such general fund to the revolving fund; and;

2. Shall, in addition to such transfer or transfers from the general fund, or in lieu thereof, levy and collect for such revolving fund such a tax, hereby declared to be for a public purpose, on all the taxable property in the City of Polson, Montana, as shall be necessary to meet the financial requirements of such fund, such levy, together with such transfer, not to exceed in any one year five per cent (5) of the principal amount of the outstanding special improvement district bonds.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby declared an emergency existing and this ordinance is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Polson, Montana, and the inhabitants therein, and by reason thereof shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 4. This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 5. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 236

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS OR TRANSIENT VENDORS OR MERCHANDISE IN THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA: DECLARING IT TO BE A NUISANCE FOR THOSE ENGAGING IN SUCH PURSUITS TO GO IN OR UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES WITHOUT HAVING BEEN REQUESTED OR INVITED TO DO SO: PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, THAT the practice of going in and upon private residences in the City of Polson,
