RESOLUTION NO. 130

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Honorable Mayor and the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, in regular meeting assembled, that

Whereas, petitions are now being circulated for an initiative measure to amend the Workmen's Compensation Law of the State of Montana in many respects, and

Whereas, such amendments would place a tremendous and unreasonable burden on the economy of the entire State of Montana and this community, and would serve to discourage new industry coming in and drive present industry from this state thereby creating more unemployment, and

Whereas, such burden would fall not on industry alone but on all state, county and municipal bodies and all taxpayers of this state, and that additional taxes in some unknown but extremely large amount would be required to finance such a program, and that all governmental activities would necessarily have to be curtailed because of such financial load, and

Whereas, many state, county and municipal officials and employees are covered by the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act, and are therefore vitally interested in it, and

Whereas, many persons have been and are now being asked to sign such petitions without have a complete and full understanding of the measure and the bad effects it would have on both employer and employee,

NOW THEREFORE, being gravely concerned regarding the welfare of our state and this community and particularly regarding the dangers incident to such initiative measure, we hereby place ourselves on record as being vigorously opposed to such petitions and such measure and that we further urge all citizens and taxpayers to refuse to sign such petitions and to remove their signatures from any such petition which they may have heretofore signed or to sign a withdrawal petition if the original petition is not now available.

RESOLUTION NO. 131

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 120, OF SAID CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, PASSED ON THE 24TH DAY OF AUGUST 1951, CHANGING THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN SAID RESOLUTION PROVIDED FOR, AND ALSO CHANGING THE MATURITY DATE THEREOF, AND REPEALING ANY RESOLUTION IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

WHEREAS: The City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, did on the 24th day of August 1951, pass Resolution No. 120, which said resolution provided for the issuance of bonds in the amount of \$59,400.00 in and for Special Improvement Sanitary Sewer District No. 10, AND

WHEREAS: Said resolution No. 120 aforesaid provided that said bonds bear date of issuance of September 1st, 1951, and maturity date of January 1st, 1971, AND

WHEREAS: Since considerable time has elapsed since the passing of said Resolution No. 120 aforesaid, and it now appears, that it will be to the best interests of the citizens of the City of Polson, Montana, and particularly Special Improvement District No. 10, the date of said bonds, or the date of issuance of said bonds be fixed as May 1st, 1952, and that the maturity date of said bonds be January 1st, 1972.

WHEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, as follows:

Sec. 1. That Section 2 of Resolution No. 120 be amended to read as follows:

"That said Special Improvement Sanitary Sewer District No. 10 bonds shall bear date of May 1st, 1952, shall be in denominations of \$500.00 each, except bond No. 1 which shall be in denomination of \$400.00, shall be numbered from 1 to 119 inclusive, shall bear interest at the rate of 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ per cent per annum, payable annually on the first day of January, and shall bear maturity date of January 1st, 1972, and shall be subject to redemption by the City of Polson through the City Treasurer in the order of their number as provided by statute".

Sec. 2. That Section 4 of said Resolution No. 120 be amended to provide that the date of said bonds be changed from September 1st, 1951 to May 1st, 1952, and that the maturity date be changed from January 1st, 1971 to January 1st, 1972.

Sec. 3. That such parts of Resolution No. 120 aforesaid and as passed August 24th, 1951, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.

Passed by the City Council of the City of Polson, and approved by the Mayor this 16th day of May, 1952.
