

RESOLUTION NO. 137

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, TO CREATE A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 18 IN THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DEFINING THE BOUNDARY OF THE SAME, DESCRIBING THE GENERAL CHARACTER OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT, GIVING AN ESTIMATE OF THE COST THEREOF, AND THE APPROXIMATE COST OF MAINTAINING SUCH LIGHTS AND SUPPLYING ELECTRICAL CURRENT, THEREFORE, FOR THE FIRST YEAR, AND THE PORTION OF THE COSTS TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE PROPERTY EMBRACED WITHIN SAID DISTRICT, AND FIXING THE TIME WHEN AND THE PLACE WHERE SAID CITY COUNCIL WILL HEAR AND PASS UPON ALL PROTESTS THAT MAY BE MADE AGAINST THE MAKING OF SAID IMPROVEMENT.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

SECTION 1. That it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana to create and establish in said City of Polson, Montana, a Special Improvement Lighting District for the purpose of constructing and establishing a mercury-vapor type of street lighting, within said Improvement Lighting District, including all streets, alleys and inter-sections within the boundaries hereinafter particularly described.

SECTION 2. That said Special Improvement Lighting District shall be known and designated as Special Improvement Lighting District No. 18.

SECTION 3. That the boundaries of said Special Improvement Lighting District No. 18 in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana are designated and described, as follows:

All those certain lots, including Block Eighteen (18) adjoining and abutting on the following portions of streets in the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, to-wit:

Beginning at west side of intersection of 2nd Street East and 2nd Avenue and running two blocks west on 2nd Avenue to intersection of Main Street and 2nd Avenue, thence four blocks south on Main Street to north side of intersection of Main Street and 6th Avenue; also beginning at south side of intersection of 1st Street East and 1st Avenue and running four blocks south on 1st Street East to intersection of 1st Street East and 5th Avenue; also two blocks west on 3rd Avenue from intersection of 1st Street East and 3rd Avenue to east side of intersection of 3rd Avenue and 1st Street West.

SECTION 4. That the District included within said boundaries is hereby declared to be the District benefitted by the making of said improvements and that the property included within the boundaries of said District is hereby declared to be the property to be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvement.

SECTION 5. Said lots and blocks benefitted by and to be assessed for the construction of said improvements are located in the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, and are described as follows, to-wit:

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7) of Block Five (5);

Lots Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Six (6);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7) of Block Nine (9);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Ten (10);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8) of Block Eleven (11);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6) and Twelve (12) of Block Thirteen (13);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Fourteen (14);

Lots Six (6) and Seven (7) of Block Fifteen (15);

All of Block Eighteen (18);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) of Block Nineteen (19);

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) Five (5), Six (6) of Block Twenty (20);

Lots One (1) and Twelve (12) of Block Twenty-Three (23);

Lots Six (6) and Seven (7) of Block Twenty-Four (24).

SECTION 6. That the general character of the improvement to be made will be a high mercury-vapor type of street lighting with wires overhead, painted and treated wooden poles with about four (4) to the block in staggered position with brace and guy poles. The estimated cost of said improvement is Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$14,400.00), and that the estimated cost of maintaining such lights for the first year is Seven Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$780.00), and the estimated cost of supplying electrical current, therefore, for the first year is Ten Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$1030.00).

SECTION 7. That the proportion of the cost for the construction and installation of said improvement assessed against the property embraced within said District shall be three-fourths (3/4ths) of the entire cost and the proportion of the cost of maintaining such lights and supplying electrical current, therefore, for the first year to be assessed against the property embraced within the District shall be one-fourth (1/4th) of the entire cost and each lot, or parcel of land, within such District bordering or abutting upon the street, or streets, wherein the improvement has been made, shall be assessed in proportion to the lineal feet abutting or bordering the same, and the proportionate cost of the construction and installation of such improvement will be approximately Two Dollars (\$2.00) per running foot of each such lot or parcel of lot, except that the property owned by the Federal Government and the City of Polson shall be excluded from such assessment.

SECTION 8. That at any time within fifteen (15) days after the date of the first publication of notice of passage of this Resolution, any owner of property within said district which shall be assessed for the cost and expense of making said improvement may make and file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Montana, a written protest against the proposed work and against the extent or the creation of said district, or both. Such protests must be in writing and be delivered to the City Clerk at or before five o'clock P. M. of the last day within said fifteen (15) day period; and said Clerk shall endorse thereon the date and hour of its receipt by him.

SECTION 9. That on Monday, the 3rd day of May, 1954, at eight o'clock P.M., at the City Hall in the City of Polson, Montana, (the same being the regular meeting place of the City Council) the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, will meet to hear and pass upon all protests so made and to hear objections to the official and final adoption of this Resolution, at which time and place any owner of property within said District shall have the right to appear in person, or by attorney, and show cause, if any there be, why said improvement shall not be made, or said District created.

SECTION. 10. That the City Clerk be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the passage and approval of this Resolution, as provided by law.

NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, held on Monday, April 5, 1954, a Resolution of Intention to create a special improvement lighting district was passed by the City Council of said city.

That the number of said Special Improvement Lighting District was designated as Special Improvement Lighting District No. 18.

That the general character of the improvement to be made will be the construction and installation of a high mercury-vapor type of street lighting with wires overhead, painted and treated wooden poles with about four (4) to the block in staggered position with brace and guy poles, extending upon and along the following described streets in the City of Polson, Montana:

All those certain lots, including Block Eighteen (18) adjoining and abutting on the following portions of streets in the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, to-wit:
 Beginning at west side of intersection of 2nd Street East and 2nd Avenue and running two blocks west on 2nd Avenue to intersection of Main Street and 2nd Avenue, thence four blocks south on Main Street to north side of intersection of Main Street and 6th Avenue; also beginning at south side of intersection of 1st Street East and 1st Avenue and running four blocks south on 1st Street East to intersection of 1st Street East and 5th Avenue; also two blocks west on 3rd Avenue from intersection of 1st Street East and 3rd Avenue to east side of intersection of 3rd Avenue and 1st Street West.

That the lots to be benefitted by and assessed for the construction of said street lighting system are located in the Original Townsite of the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, to-wit:

Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6, and 7 of Block 5;
 Lots 6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 of Block 6;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6 and 7 of Block 9;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11, and 12 of Block 10;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7, and 8 of Block 11;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6, and 12 of Block 13;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 of Block 14;
 Lots 6 and 7 of Block 15;
 All of Block 18;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 of Block 19;
 Lots 1,2,3,4,5, and 6 of Block 20;
 Lots 1 and 12 of Block 23;
 Lots 6 and 7 of Block 24;

That the estimated cost and expense of said improvement is approximately Fourteen Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$14,400.00), and that three-fourths (3/4ths) of such cost shall be assessed against the lots and parts of lots above described; that the estimated cost of maintaining such lighting system for the first year is Seven Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$780.00); and that the estimated cost of supplying electrical energy therefore is Ten Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$1030.00), and that one-fourth (1/4th) of the cost of such maintenance and electrical current shall be assessed against the lots above described.

That any owner of property liable to be assessed for said work may make a written protest against the proposed work or against the extent or creation of the district to be assessed, or both, at any time within fifteen (15) days after the date of the first publication of this notice. Such protests must be in writing and be delivered to the City Clerk not later than five o'clock P.M., of the last day within said fifteen (15) days period.

That on Monday, the 3rd day of May, 1954, at eight o'clock P.M., at the City Hall in the City of Polson, Montana, (the same being the regular meeting place of the City Council) the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, will meet to hear and pass upon all protests so made and to hear objections to the official and final adoption of this Resolution, at which time and place any owner of property within said district shall have the right to appear in person, or by attorney, and show cause, if any there be, why said improvement shall not be made, or said district created.

A RESOLUTION CREATING SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 18
 OF AND IN THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, DEFINING
 THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SAME, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING
 AND INSTALLING A MERCURY VAPOR TYPE OF STREET LIGHTING WITHIN SAID
 DISTRICT, AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF, AND CALLING OF BIDS THEREOF,
 AND THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS IN PAYMENT THEREOF, THE MANNER OF THEIR SALE,
 AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE PROPORTION OF THE COSTS OF SUCH
 CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTAINING THE SAME AND SUPPLYING ELECTRICAL CURRENT FOR
 SUCH LIGHTS TO BE ASSESSED AGAINST THE PROPERTY EMBRACED WITHIN SAID DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana did on the 5th day of April, 1954 in regular session pass Resolution of Intention No. 137 to create such improvement lighting district No. 18 within the said City of Polson, Montana, and the district proposed to be created thereby, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Resolution, the City Council caused a notice of the passage and adoption of said Resolution, to be published in the Flathead Courier, a weekly newspaper, published in the City of Polson, Montana on the 8th day of April, 1954, and for a period of more than fifteen (15) days preceding the 3rd day of May, 1954, and,
