RESOLUTION NO. 139

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON SO AS TO INCLUDE THOSE CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED, WHICH ARE CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF POLSON (AND BELONGING TO THE POLSON LUMBER COMPANY, A CORPORATION AND NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY, A CORPORATION.)

WHEREAS, it appears to the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Polson that it will be to the best interests of the City of Polson and the inhabitants thereof and of all of the inhabitants of the said territory or parcels of land, as aforesaid, that the boundaries of the City of Polson shall be extended so as to include the same whithin the copporate limits thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Polson that it is the judgment of said Council that it will be to the best interests of the City of Polson and the inhabitants thereof and of the inhabitants of said territory or parcels of land, as aforesaid, and hereinafter described that the boundaries of the City of Polson be extended so as to include within the corporate limits of said city the four (4) tracts of land belonging to and occupies by the Polson Lumber Company, a corporate, described as follows to-wit:

Part of Lots 3 and 4, Section 4, Township 22 North, Range 20 West of the Montana Meridian, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the East boundary line of the original townsite of Polson, Montana, 140 feet North of the southeast corner of Block 7, thence East 52 feet to the intersection of the right-of-way of the Lake Front Spur of the Northern Pacific Railway, thence in a northerly direction along a 13 degree curve on said right-of-way line 165 feet to point of tangent, thence N. 06 degrees 30' W. 20 ft. to the intersection of the East boundary line of the original townsite of Polson, Montana, thence South along said boundary line 181 feet to point of beginning, containing 3430 square feet, more or less of Lot 4, Township 22 N., Range 20 W. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall forthwith notify in writing all property holders within the boundaries of said territory and cause to be published in the Flathead Courier, the newspaper published nearest such tracts or parcels of land, at least oneea week for two successive weeks, a notice to the effect that this Resolution has been duly and regularly passed, and that for a period of twenty (20) days after the first publication of said notice, said City Clerk will receive expressions of approval or disapproval, in writing, of the proposed extension of the boundaries of the City of Polson from the free-holders of the territory proposed to be embraced therein.
