## RESOLUTION NO. 143

A RESOLUTION CREATING OIL DISTRICT NO. 14-P, DEFINING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND DESIGNATING THE COST THEREFOR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA:

SECTION 1. That an oil sprinkling district to be known and designated as Oil District No. 14-P is hereby created.

"SECTION 2. That the boundaries of said Oil District No. 14-P are and shall be as to include all of the area or that portion of the City of Polson including the streets upon which the following described lots and blocks border:

All of Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, Lots 2 to 12 inclusive in Block 7, Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 8, all of Block 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31 of the Original Townsite of the City of Polson.

All of Block 1 and 2, Lots 1, and 7 to 16 inclusive in Block 3, All of Blocks 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 6 and 7, Block 2; Lots 1 and 12, Block 3; Lots 6 and 7, Block 4; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive of Block 5; Lots 1 and 12 Block 6; Lots 6 and 7 of Block 7; Lots 5 and 6 of Block 10; Lots 1 and 12 of Block 11; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive of Block 12; Lots 7 to 11 inclusive of Block 13; Lots 1 to 6 inclusive of Block 14; Lots 6 and 7 of Block 15; Lots 6 and 7 of Block 18; Lots 1 and 12 of Block 19 of the Grand-view Addition to the City of Polson;

Lots 1 to 4 inclusive of Block 1 and Lots 5 to 8 inclusive of Block 2, Pollmann Addition to the City of Polson.

Hank Meyers property, Lots 6 and 7 in Block 2; Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 3; Lots 7 to 12 inclusive in Block 4; Ben McNeeley, Frank Bare, Leo James properties; Lots 5 and 7 in Block 7, Polson Heights Addition to the City of Polson.

Lot A in Block 12; Lots 1 and 12 in Block 17; and Hospital Block of Pend D8 Oreille Heights Addition to the City of Polson.

Lot 1 of Block 1; Lots 22 to 34 inclusive of Block 1; Lots 13 to 24 inclusive of Block 8; Lots 13 to 24 inclusive of Block 9; Roman Catholic Bishop (church) and the Northern Pacific Railway Property; Lots 12 to 25 inclusive in Block 4; Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 5; and Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 12 of City Center Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 1, 2, and 3 in Block 2; Michel Addition to Dewey Lumber Tract; all of Block 1, 2, 3, and 4, Michel Addition to the City of Polson.

The McIntire Tract adjoining Riverside Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 2; Lots 1 to 12 inclusive in Block 3 of Elevation Addition to the City of Polson.

All of Block 1 of Church Addition to the City of Bolson.

Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 1; Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 2; Lots 1 to 6 inclusive in Block 3; and Lots 1 to 4 inclusive in Block 4 of Lewis Addition to the City of Polson.

Lots 1 to 6 inclusive and Lot 12 in Block 1; Lots 1 to 8 inclusive in Block 2; The Polson Flour Mill Block; Lots 1 and 12 in Block 5; Lots 6 and 7 in Block 5; Lots 1 and 12 in Block 4; Lots 6, 7 and 12 in Block 6; Lots 1 and 12 in Block 7, and Lots 1 and 12 in Block 11 of the Central Addition to the City of Polson.

All of Cramer Sub-division to the City of Polson, and all of Lake Shore A ddition to the City of Polson.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists and it is necessary immediately for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson that this resolution shall have effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 4, That the estimated cost of oiling said district as aforesaid, shall be the sum of Eight and 50/100 Dollars (\$8.50) approximately, nor not to exceed the sum of Eight and 50/100 Dollars (\$8.50) per lot.

SECTION 5. That all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

## ORDINANCE NO. 250

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA, FIXING SALARIES OF ALL CITY OFFICIALS AND OFFICERS: FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

SECTION 1. The salaries of the following officers and city officials are fixed as follows: Water and Street Commissioner \$350.00 per month; Assistant Water Commissioner \$300.00 per month; Fire Chief \$225.00 per month; City Clerk \$325.00 per month; Chief of Police \$250.00 per month; one other full time police \$250.00 per month; City Attorney if any, \$50.00 per month; Police Judge \$20.00 per month. Councilmen each \$15.00 per month; Mayor \$50.00 per month, and if no city attorney, the mayor will perform legal duties without charge.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances in conflict are herewith; repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance takes effect 30 days after its passage and approval.
