## **RESOLUTION 918**

## PLACING CITY MUNICIPAL SERVICES LEVY ON THE BALLOT

WHEREAS, a request has been made to the Polson City Council that the Council submit to the electors of the City of Polson the question of whether or not to levy an additional tax of up to 19.95 additional mills per year for the purpose of providing funding for Polson Police

Department operations including the hiring of one additional officer, creating a career ladder in order to improve the retention of trained officers, and the purchase of public safety equipment.

WHEREAS, public comment was taken on March 20th, 2006 on whether or not to submit the question of a levy for public safety operations and the purchase of public safety equipment to the electors; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the public interest to submit the question of a levy for public safety operations and the purchase of public safety equipment to the electors;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Lake County Elections Administrator is directed to place the question of a levy for public safety operations and the purchase of public safety equipment of approximately 19.95 mills per year on the ballot for the primary election to be held on Tuesday, June 6, 2006.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the question shall be presented to the electors in substantially the following form:

FOR authorizing a levy of up to approximately 19.95 mills raising approximately \$130,000 per year for the purpose of funding public safety operations and the purchase of public safety equipment for the City of Polson Police Department. If approved, the requested levy could increase the annual taxes on a home with as assessed value of
