## **RESOLUTION NO. 1025**

A RESOLUTION FINDING AND DECLARING THAT THE 2012 WATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR WHICH AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT HAS BEEN PREPARED CONSTITUTES A MANAGEABLE ENVIRONMENTAL RISK AND IS ELIGIBLE TO BE DECLARED EXEMPT FROM FURTHER ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW.

WHEREAS, the City of Polson maintains a system of potable public drinking water including sourcing, storage, and distribution components, which requires upgrade and improvement from time to time; and,

WHEREAS, the Water & Sewer Department has caused to be completed an Environmental Review checklist by Anderson-Montgomery Engineering, in contemplation of preparing to seek monies for such water system improvement from the Montana Treasure State Endowment Program (TSEP), attached hereto as Exhibit A; and,

WHEREAS, Exhibit A adequately documents that the proposed 2012 Water System Improvement Project constitutes a manageable environmental risk:

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, LAKE COUNTY:

SECTION 1. That the 2012 Water Improvements project for which the Environmental Assessment attached hereto as Exhibit A, constitutes a manageable environmental risk and is therefore eligible to be declared exempt from further environmental review under the Montana Environmental Protection Act (MEPA) – provided the necessary public review process is implemented.

SECTION 2. All Resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are herby amended to the extent of any such conflict.
