

YOUR CITY UTILITY BILL WATER / SEWER / STORM

Basic Residential Water Bill

Monthly minimum charges for a ¾" meter

\$17.09 up to 5,000 gallons

Each additional 1,000 gallons used, up to 8,000 gallons,
bills at \$1.96

\$22.97 for 8,000 gallons

Each additional 1,000 gallons used, up to 11,000
gallons, bills at \$2.54

\$30.59 for 11,000 gallons

Each additional 1,000 gallons used bills at \$4.33

Basic Sewer Bill

Monthly Base Charge \$39.64

Usage is Based on water consumption*

Each 1,000 gallons bills at \$5.20

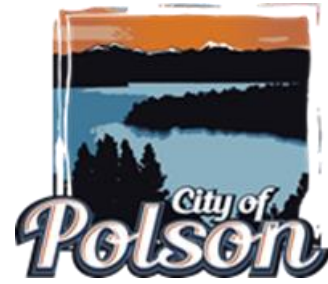
There is a \$4 per month storm drain fee



Typical Water Usage:

- Bath = 42 gallons
- Shower = 17 gallons
- Washing one load of laundry = 45 gallons
- Each toilet flush = 3 gallons

*November – April: Actual Sewer Usage
May – October: Sewer Average based on winter usage



WATER LEAK STATISTICS AND CONSERVATION TIPS

A dripping leak consumes 450 gallons per month

A ¼ inch leak consumes 456,800 gallons per month

A ½ inch leak consumes 1,827,000 per month



Common water loss examples:

- Leaking toilet @ ½ GPM = 21,500 gal/mo
- Dripping irrigation @ GPM = 43,200 gal/mo
- Watering your garden for 2 hours @ 5 GPM = 18,000 gal/mo
- Stuck Ice maker @ 2 GPM = 86,400 gal/mo
- Stuck Valve in water for 30 mins = 240 gal

Water Conservation tips:

- ✓ Use a low-flow showerhead
- ✓ Turn off water while brushing teeth
- ✓ Water early in the morning while its cooler
- ✓ Fill up your sink while handwashing dishes
- ✓ Only run dishwashers and washing machines when they are full
